

THE COUNTY OF DURHAM (VARIOUS STREETS, WOLSINGHAM)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 1977

The County Council of Durham (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1) (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968; Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967 hereby make the following Order

1. In this Order:-

"disabled persons vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 1975.

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975

"parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specifications for Parking Discs (B.S. No. 4631: 1970) coloured orange and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins and

"relevant position" means

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

2. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of road specified in Schedule I of this Order.

3. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. in any day on the length of road specified in Schedule II of this Order.

4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. during the period 1st April to 30th September in any year, both dates inclusive on the lengths of roads specified in Schedule III of this Order.

5. Nothing in Articles 2, 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in those Articles as the case may be for so long as may be necessary:-

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) to enable the vehicle if it is in the service of or employed by the Post Office to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lengths of roads so referred to or the laying, erections, alteration or repair in or near the said lengths of roads of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878;
- (e) to enable the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(f) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage, situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of roads

(g) Police, fire brigade, ambulance and emergency vehicles.

6. Nothing in Articles 2, 3 and 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and a parking disc (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the sides of roads referred to in those Articles for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road.)

7. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

8. This Order shall come into operation on the 3rd October 1977 and may be cited as The County of Durham (Various Streets, Wolsingham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1977.

SCHEDULE I

PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME

- (i) North side of Front Street (Road A.689) from a point seven yards west of the Post Office for a distance of 37 yards in a westerly direction
- (ii) North side of Front Street (Road A.689) from its junction with Church Lane for a distance of 20 yards in an easterly direction.

SCHEDULE II

PROHIBITION OF WAITING BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 8.00 a.m.
and 6.00 p.m. IN ANY DAY

Both sides of High Street (Road A.689) from the junction with Church Lane to the junction with the unclassified road Leazes Lane leading to the reservoir but excluding the lay-by near the garage

SCHEDULE III

PROHIBITION OF WAITING BETWEEN 1ST APRIL AND 30TH
SEPTEMBER IN ANY YEAR BOTH DATES INCLUSIVE BETWEEN THE
HOURS OF 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m.

Both sides of Road A.689 at East End from the Market Place to Lister Terrace.

Both sides of the Causeway from its junction with Road A.689 for a distance of 183 yards in a southerly direction.
