

**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM
(STANHOPE)
(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING)(AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2013**

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part 1

General

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Stanhope) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) (Amendment No 1) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on 23 September 2013.

Amendments

2. The following amendments have been made to the under-noted Order:

The County Council of Durham (Stanhope) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) Order 2011.

Article 2 - Interpretation

- A new definition of "civil enforcement Officer" has been inserted:

"civil enforcement officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to the provisions of Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004";

- The definitions of "disabled person's badge" and "disabled person's parking disc" have been amended as follows:

"disabled person's badge" and "disabled person's parking disc have the same meaning as in the Disabled Person's (Badge's for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended);

- New definitions of "penalty charge" and "penalty charge notice" have been inserted:

"penalty charge" means a charge set by Durham County Council pursuant to the provisions of Section 77 of the Traffic Management Act 2004";

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004";

- The definition of "relevant position" has been amended as follows:

"relevant position" in relation to a disabled person's badge has the same meaning as in the Disabled Person's (Badge's for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended)

Part II - Revocation

- The following Order previously revoked in error is to be reinstated within the Order:

Road Traffic Act, 1960. The County Council of Durham (Various Streets, Wolsingham and Stanhope) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1967

Part IV

A new Article 9 has been inserted, which reads:

Contravention and Enforcement

9. (1) If a vehicle is in contravention of a provision of this Order a penalty charge shall be payable.
- (2) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may then be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with the requirements of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended.

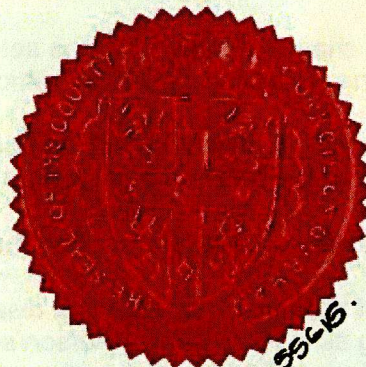

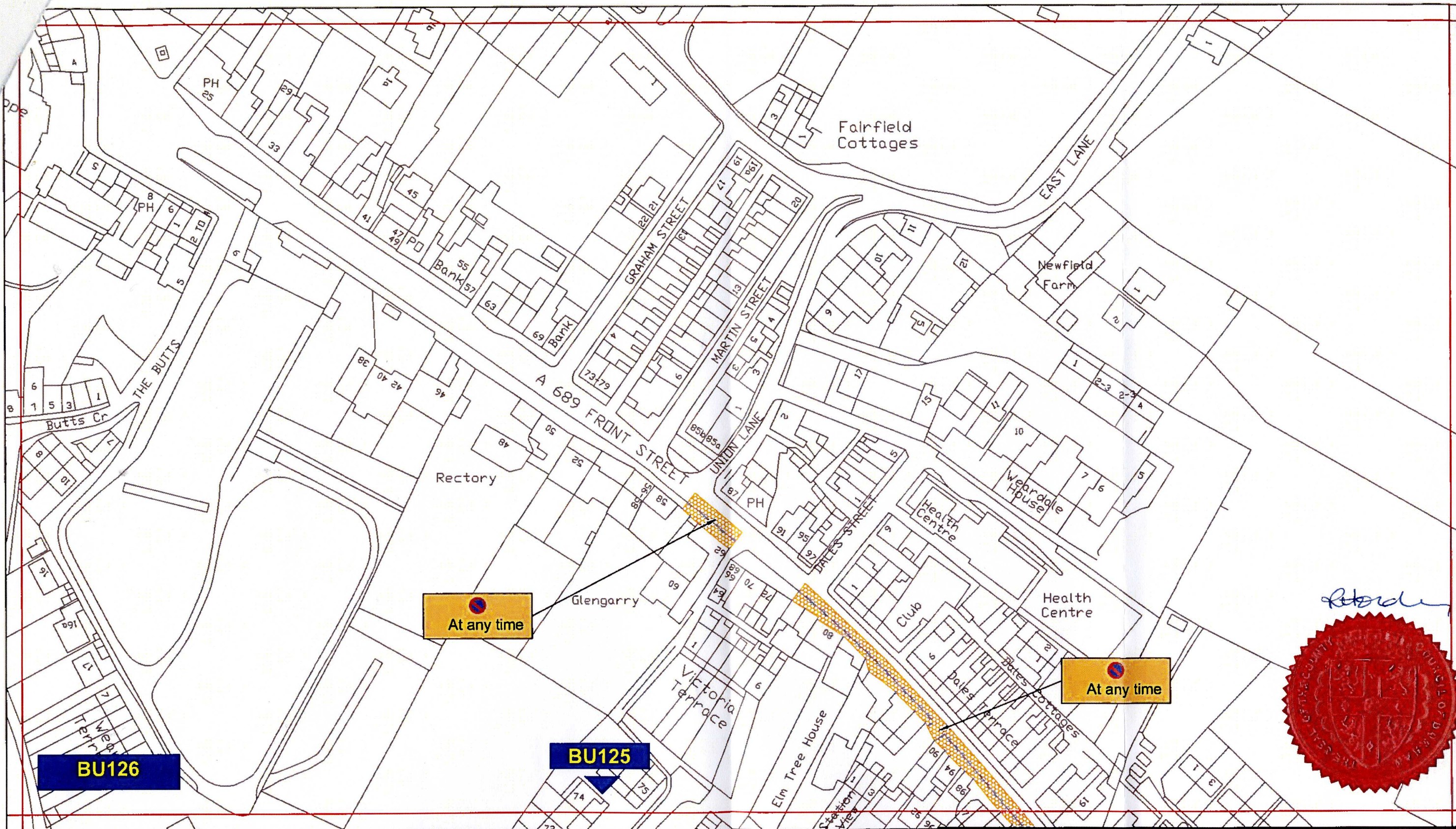
Saving

3. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.



-  Individual Reference Number

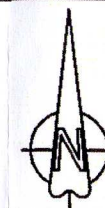
