

**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM  
(NEWTON AYCLIFFE)  
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROHIBITION OF  
STOPPING, PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY) (AMENDMENT No. 1)  
ORDER 2013**

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

**Part I**

**General**

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Newton Aycliffe) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Prohibition of Stopping, Permit Holders Only) (Amendment No. 1) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on 16 September 2013.

**Part II**

**Amendments**

2. (A) The following amendments have been made to the under-noted Order:

The County Council of Durham ((Newton Aycliffe) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Prohibition of Stopping, Permit Holders Only) Order 2012.

(B) **ARTICLES:**

- (i) **Article 2 – Interpretation :** The following have been inserted:

"civil enforcement officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council pursuant to the provisions of Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"council" means The County Council of Durham;

"liveried vehicle" means a vehicle having a distinctive design and colour scheme used to distinguish the fire & rescue service, ambulance and police vehicles;

"parking contravention" has the same meaning assigned to it by Section 73 and Part 1 of Schedule 7 to the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"penalty charge" means a charge set by The County Council of Durham pursuant to the provisions of Section 77 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

- (ii) A new Article 13(6) has been inserted which reads:

Nothing in Article 4 shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicles being used for funeral or wedding purposes on the undernoted lengths of roads as shown on individual plan ref DZ76:

- (a) C34 Burn Lane from its junction with B6443 Central Avenue in a north westerly direction, for a distance of 43 metres.
- (b) B6443 Central Avenue from its junction with C34 Burn Lane in a north easterly direction for a distance of 71 metres.

(iii) A new Article 14 has been inserted which reads:

#### **Contravention & Enforcement**

- 1. If a vehicle is left at any time in contravention of a provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable.
- 2. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer.

(iii) Existing Articles 14 and 15 have been renumbered as Articles 15 and 16 respectively.

#### **(C) SCHEDULES:**

**Schedule 1** – Plan reference DZ76 dated 22/8/13 has been inserted.

**Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 6 and 7** – Plan reference DZ75 dated 19/7/12 has been removed from these schedules and been replaced with a plan bearing the same reference dated 22/8/13.

**Schedule 5** – Plan reference DZ76 dated 19/7/12 has been removed from this schedule and has been placed with a plan bearing the same reference dated 22/8/13.

### **Part III**

#### **Saving**

- 3. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- 4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

### **Part IV**

#### **Contravention & Enforcement**

- 5. If a vehicle is left at any time in contravention of a provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable.

6. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer.




