THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (HIGH FORCE / MIDDLETON-IN-TEESDALE) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING) ORDER 2011

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part 1

General

 This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (High Force /, Middletonin-Teesdale) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on 17 May 2012...

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Person's (Badge's for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended);

"disabled person's parking disc" means a device which:

- is 125 millimetres square coloured blue, if issued on or after1 April 2000, or orange if issued before that date
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter hour during which a period of waiting began.

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"masterplan" means the plan showing the total area covered by all of the individual map schedules for each location included in a Map Based Road Traffic Regulation Order";

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act;

"parking disc" means a device which:

- is 125 millimetres square coloured blue, if issued on or after 1 April 2000, or orange if issued before that date
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter hour during which a period of waiting began;

"relevant position" means:-

- (i) in the case of a disabled person's badge;
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited thereon; or
 - (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position in the vehicle so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from outside the vehicle; and
- (ii) in respect of a disabled person's parking disc:-
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited thereon; or
 - (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle; so that when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from outside of the vehicle;

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

Part II

Revocation

3. (a) The following Order is to be revoked in part:

The County Council of Durham (Various Schools, Sedgefield, Teesdale, Wear Valley Areas and Burnhope) (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2011 (Schedule 2, item 7)

(b) The following Order is to be revoked in full:

The County of Durham (High Force, Middleton-in-Teesdale) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1989

Part III

Prohibition of Waiting

4. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 1 to this Order.

No Stopping on School Entrance Markings

5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads on such days and during such times as identified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order.

"relevant position" means:-

- (i) in the case of a disabled person's badge;
 - in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited thereon; or
 - (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position in the vehicle so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from outside the vehicle; and
- (ii) in respect of a disabled person's parking disc:-
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited thereon; or
 - (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle; so that when marked to show the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from outside of the vehicle;

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

Part II

Part III

Prohibition of Waiting

4. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 1 to this Order.

No Stopping on School Entrance Markings

5. Save as provided in Article 6 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads on such days and during such times as identified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order.

8. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
