## THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (COCKFIELD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2011

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

#### General

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Cockfield) (Prohibition of Stopping) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on 17 May 2012.

## Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

#### Part II

#### Revocation

3. The following Order is hereby revoked in part:-

The County Council of Durham (Various Schools, Sedgefield, Teesdale, Wear Valley Areas and Burnhope) (No stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2011. (Schedule 2, Item 3)

## Part III

## No Stopping on School Entrance Markings

4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait on the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads on such days and during such times as specified on the individual plan(s) detailed in the Schedule to this Order.

## MAMPUG TO J Part IV

## **Exemptions**

- 5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- (2) anything done in accordance with any restrictions or requirements indicated by traffic signs placed on the roads by or on behalf of Durham Constabulary.
  - (3) any vehicle being used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the service of a universal service provider.

- 6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of THIS Order shall prevail.
- 7. The restrictions and prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
