- (b) Articles 7, 8, 9, 14(3), 17(2) 19(2) reference to "permission of a civil enforcement officer" has been inserted.

- (d) Article 11: Sub Article (2) has been amended to read:

Save as provided in Article 20 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle loading or unloading goods, to wait in a loading bay on such days and during such hours as identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 5 to this Order.

(e) Article 12: Sub article (4) has been amended to read:

"Save as provided in Article 20 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit a motor vehicle or motor cycle to wait in a parking place, authorised under paragraph (1) of this Article, for a period exceeding the maximum stay specified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 6 of this Order, or to return within the period also specified on those plans."

(f) Article 13 - sub-article (4) has been amended to read:

Save as provided in Article 20 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than one displaying a Disabled Person's Badge/Disabled Person's Parking Disc to park in a Disabled Badge Holders Only Parking Place on such days and during such times as identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 7 to this Order.

- (g) Article 15 sub-articles (1), (2) and (3) have been amended to read:
 - (1) The areas of highway identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 9 to this Order are hereby designated as Permit Holder parking places to be used only by those vehicles which display a valid permit.
 - (2) Each parking place <u>identified within the individual plan(s) detailed</u> in Schedule 9 to this order, authorised under paragraph (1) of this Article may be used <u>only by those motor vehicles</u> which display a valid parking permit issued by the Council and distributed by the relevant Markets Manager to Market Traders.
 - (3) The limits of each restricted bay shall be indicated, by the Council, on the highway by the appropriate traffic signs.
 - (4) Save as provided in Article 20 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle displaying a valid parking permit issued by the Council and distributed by the relevant Markets Manager to Market Traders, to wait in a permit holder only parking piace on such days and during such times identified in the individual plans detailed in Schedule 9 to this Order.
- (h) New articles 21 and 22 have been inserted which read:

Contravention and Enforcement

- 21. If a vehicle is in contravention of a provision of this Order a penalty charge shall be payable.
- 22. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may then be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer in accordance with the requirements of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended.
