(a) Article 2 – Interpretation

	Initial Charge
	12. (1) Subject to Article 41 of this Order, no person may leave or cause any vehicle to be left in a parking bay other than on such days and during such hours as identified in Schedules 4 & 5(a) to this Order, other than Christmas Day, Good Friday, New Year's Day or a Bank Holiday, except upon the payment of the charge referred to in column E of Schedule 4.
	(2) The period and payment described in paragraph (1) of this Article are hereafter called respectively "permitted hours" and the "initial charge".
	(3) Subject to Article 41 of this Order, the maximum length of time for which a vehicle may be left in a parking bay during the permitted hours on payment of the initial charge, shall be as indicated, in relation to that parking bay in column D of Schedule 4 to this Order.
	(4) The initial charge for a vehicle left in a parking bay during the permitted hours shall be the amount in relation to that parking bay, as specified in column E of Schedule 4 to this Order.
1,000	i. The initial charge becomes payable on the leaving of the vehicle in a parking bay. Payment can be made in the parking meter relating to the designated parking bay, by means of either coins of the denomination indicated on the parking meter or by the use of a credit card or debit card inserted into the parking meter, if the facility is available.
	ii. The initial charge payable at each parking bay may be varied from time to time, details of which will be made available by public notice and also via the Council's website.

	(1) There shall be a parking meter installed on or in the vicinity of each parking place designated under Article 10 of this Order.
	(2) Payment of the Initial Charge for a vehicle left in a parking place at which a parking meter is installed shall be indicated by the issue of a parking ticket.
	(3) Upon payment of the Initial Charge for a vehicle left in a parking place at which a parking meter is installed, the driver thereo shall continuously exhibit on the vehicle, in accordance with paragraph (4) of this Article, the parking ticket issued by the parking meter relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left.
