The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part I

1. General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Evenwood) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) Order 2011 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on the 1ST April 2014.

Part II

2. Amendments

a) The following Order has been altered to reflect an amendment to the existing No Stopping restriction depicted in plan CZ77:

The County Council of Durham (Evenwood) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting) Order 2011.

b) The following amendment has been made to Schedule 2:

SCHEDULE 2:

(i) Reference to plan CZ77 [dated 9/5/12] has been removed and replaced with plan a plan of the same reference dated 20/3/14.

Part III

Contravention & Enforcement

- 3. If a vehicle is left at any time in contravention of a provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable.
- 4. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer.

Saving

In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail. 498

6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
