(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING AND PROHIBITION OF STOPPING, PERMIT HOLDERS ONLY) ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT No. 1) ORDER 2014

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Newton Aycliffe)
 (Prohibition and Restriction of Walting and Loading and Prohibition of Stopping,
 Permit Holders only) Order 2012 (amendment no. 1) order 2014 and shall come into
 operation on 10 November 2014.

Amendments

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

- (i) Ketton Way (opposite Quality System Services) removal of 12m of restricted waiting. (Plan DY66)
- (ii) Durham Way North (opposite Steel and Alloy Processing) introduction of 37m of restricted parking bay (7am-6pm 2 hours no return within 2 hours) (Plan DX69)
- (iii) Greenwell Road (adjacent Newton Aycliffe Leisure Centre) introduction of a 25m restricted bay (Loading Only Mon-Sat, 8am-6pm) (Plan DY74).
- (iv) Macmillan Road around the Stephenson Way & Greenwell Road junctions introduction of no waiting at any time. (Plan DY74).
- (v) Stephenson Way (between Nos 6 & 20) removal of 46m of restricted waiting. (Plan DY74).
- (vi) Greenwell Road (adjacent Homeplan) amending the Loading Only Bay to Loading Only Mon-Sat 8am-6pm. (Plan DZ75).
- (vii) Simpasture Gate (incorporating Moule Close and Simpasture House junctions) extended the existing No Waiting At Any Time restrictions. (Plan DY72).
- (viii) All other restrictions to remain unchanged.

ARTICLES

Article 9(4) has been amended to read:

Save as provided in Article 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle displaying a valid parking permit issued by the Council and distributed by the relevant Markets Manager to Market Traders, to wait in a permit holder only parking place on such days and during such times identified in the individual plans detailed in Schedule 6b to this Order.
