

**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM
(UNC ACCESS ROAD / ALLEYWAY, LEADING TO THE REAR OF BURN PLACE /
MILL STREET, WILLINGTON)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
ORDER 2014**

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

PART I

General

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Unc Access Road / Alleyway, leading to the rear of Burn Place / Mill Street, Willington) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2014 and shall come into operation on 15 December 2014.

Definitions

2. "enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of those officers;

"invalid carriage" means a mechanically propelled vehicle the weight of which unladen does not exceed 254 kilograms and which is specifically designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical defect or disability and is used solely by such a person;

"liveried vehicle" means a vehicle having a distinctive design and colour scheme used to distinguish a police, ambulance or fire and rescue service vehicle;

"pedal cycle" means a cycle whose motive power is provided solely by the legs of its rider or riders or which complies with the requirements specified in Regulation 4 of the Electrically Assisted Pedal Cycles Regulations 1983;

PART II

Prohibition of Driving

3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

PART III

Exemptions

4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall apply to:
 - a) any vehicle being used in the service of the local authority or highway authority in pursuance of any statutory powers or duties;
 - (b) a pedal cycle; or
 - (c) a disabled invalid carriage / motability scooter.

PART IV

Saving

5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of THIS Order shall prevail.
6. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

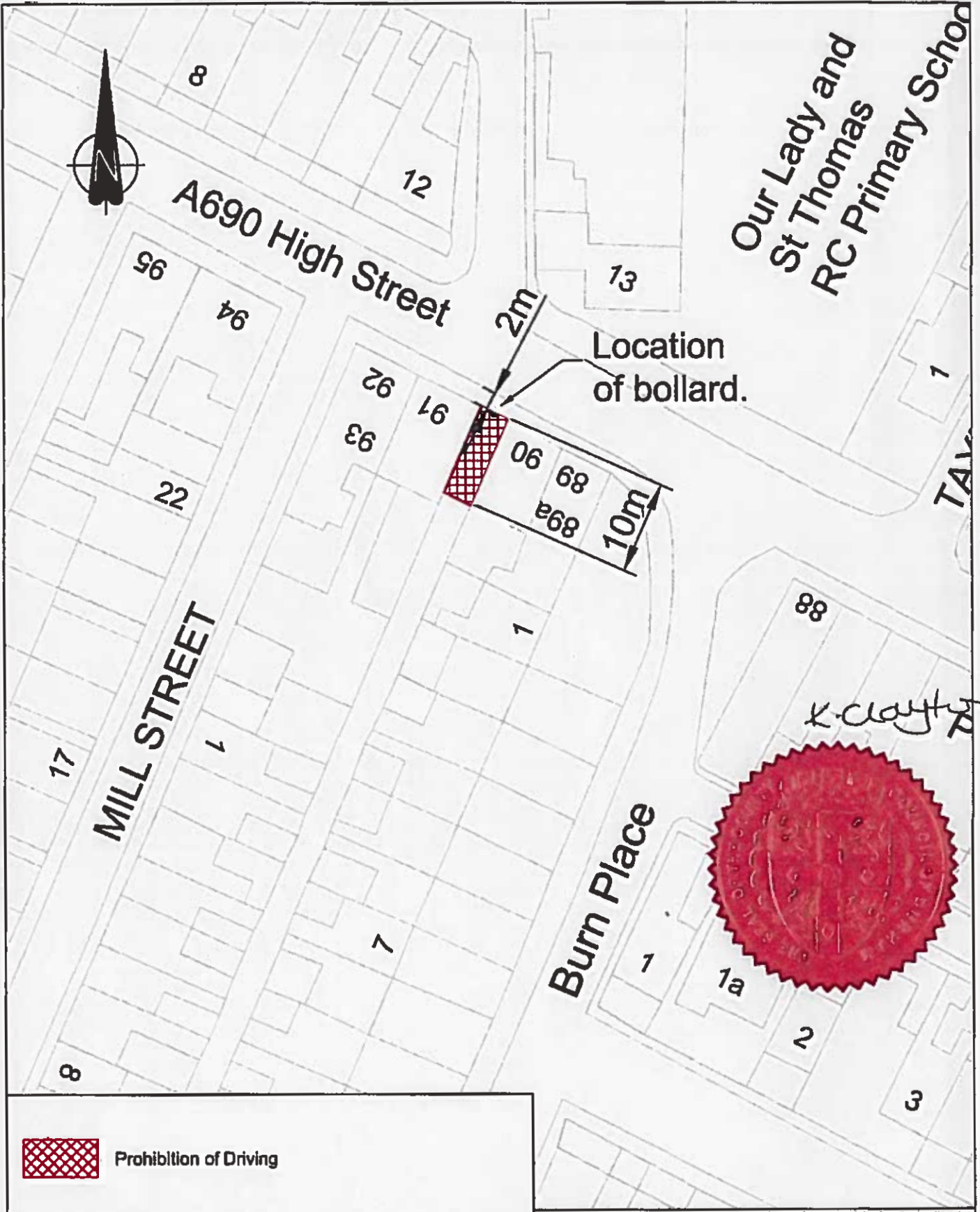
