General

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

- (i) Front St: (No's 18-24) existing disabled bay reduced in length by 5m.
- (ii) Front St: replace existing loading only Mon-Sat 8am-6pm with No waiting Mon-Sat 8am-10am and Parking Mon-Sat 10am-6pm 1 hour, no return within 3 hrs.
- (iii) Front St: (No. 10) replace existing disabled badge holder only parking 3 hour limit no return within 1 hour with no waiting Mon-Sat 8am-10am and Parking Mon-Sat 10am-6pm 1 hour, no return within 3 hrs.
- (iv) Front St: (No's 25-27) replace existing loading only bay Mon-Sat 8am-6pm with Parking Mon-Sat 8am-6pm 1 hour, no return within 3 hrs.; and
- (v) Queen Street: convert existing loading only bay Mon-Sat 8am-6pm to loading only 8am -6pm on any day.

ARTICLES

Article 6

This Article has been amended as follows:

Prohibition of Waiting

6. Save as provided in Article 22 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on such days and during such hours on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads identified in the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 1 to this Order.
