**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM

(NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS)  
ORDER 2009**

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

**Part I**

**General**

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Unc. Archery Rise / Access to Durham St Margaret's C of E Primary School) (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2009 and shall come into operation on 26 October 2009.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"civil enforcement officer" means a person pursuant to the provisions of Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"liveried vehicle" means a vehicle having a distinctive design and colour scheme used to distinguish a police, bridge brigade or ambulance vehicle;

"penalty charge" and "reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the provisions of Section 77 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, in accordance with the relevant statutory regulations or guidance given by the Secretary of State for Transport;

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued by a civil enforcement officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended;

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

## Part II

### Revocation

3. The following Order is hereby amended:-

## Part III

### No Stopping on School Entrance Markings

4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer or an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop between the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. Monday to Friday on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule appended to this Order.
5. (1) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to any liveried vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to anything done in accordance with any restrictions or requirements indicated by traffic signs placed on the roads by or on behalf of Durham Constabulary.
- (3) The vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the service of a universal service provider.
- (4) If a vehicle is left at any time in contravention of a provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable.
- (5) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may be issued by a civil enforcement officer.

## Part IV

### Contravention and Enforcement

6. If a vehicle is left at any time in contravention of a provision of this Order, a penalty charge shall be payable.
7. In the case of a vehicle in respect of which a penalty charge is payable, a penalty charge notice may then be issued by a civil enforcement officer.

### Saving

8. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of THIS Order shall prevail.
9. The restrictions and prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

**No Stopping on School Entrance Markings**  
**Monday-Friday 8.00 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.**

**St Margaret's C of E Primary School, Durham, Unclassified Archery Rise / access to Durham St Margaret's C of E Primary School:**

1. North side of road – from a point 12.65m north of the centre line with the access road to Durham St Margaret's C of E Primary School in a southerly then easterly direction for a distance of 43.56m.
2. South side of road – from a point 10.4m east of its junction line with Archery Rise in an easterly direction for a distance of 25.56m.

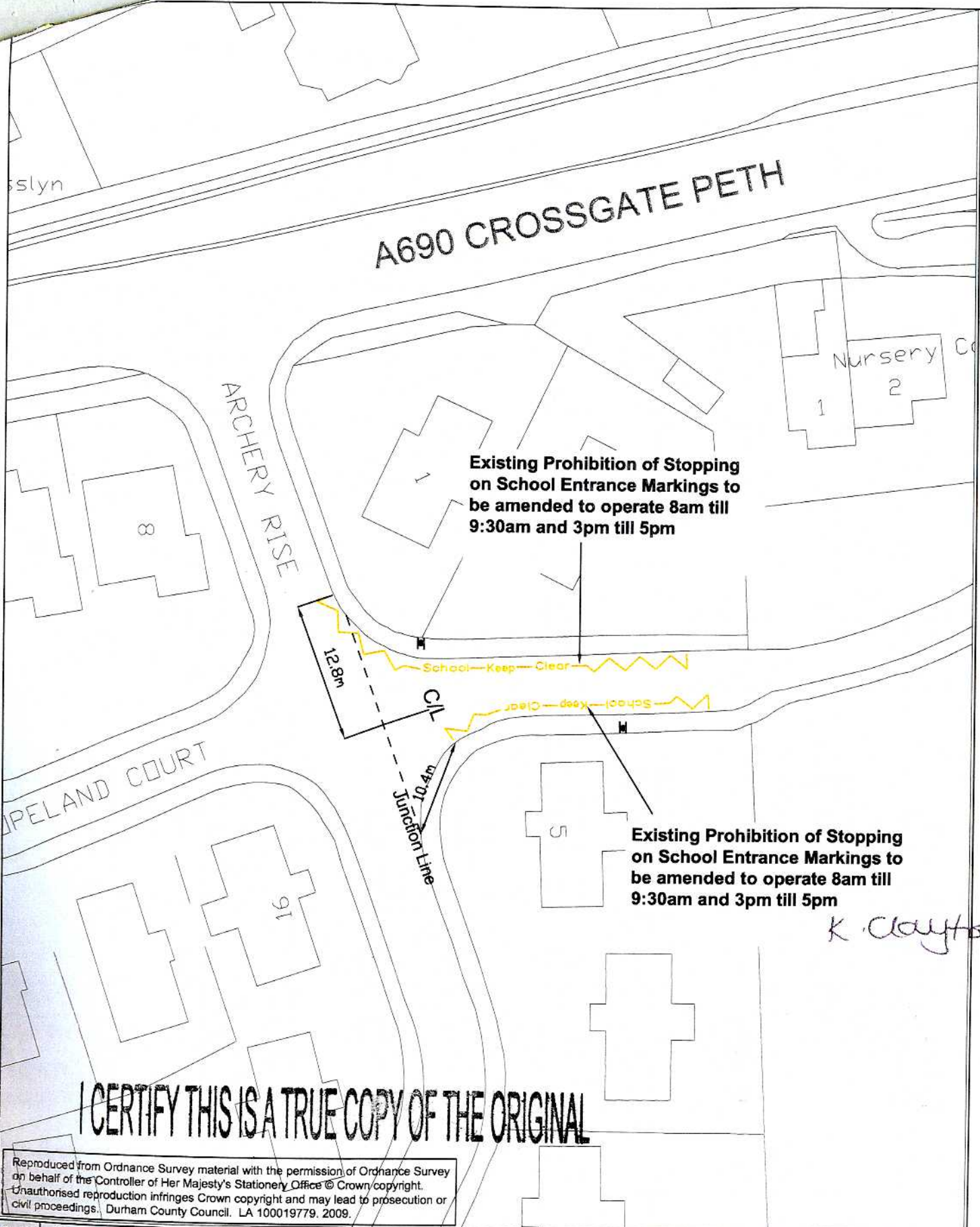
