DEFINITIONS

The following new definitions have been inserted:

"loading bay

means an area of highway designated as a loading bay under the provisions of this Order

"loading place"

and parked for the purpose of being loaded or unloaded in connection with a trade or business carried on, on or in the means an area on a highway where vehicles may be driven vicinity of the land, as defined by Section 161 of the Act

ARTICLES

The following Clauses have been inserted:

Loading Only

- 8A (1) The areas of highway identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 3A to this Order are hereby designated to be used as loading bays, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the waiting of vehicles for the purpose of loading or unloading goods only on such days and during such times as specified.
- (N enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, other than a vehicle loading or unloading goods, to wait in a loading bay on such days and during such hours as identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 3A to this direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer or a civil Save as provided in Article 22 of this Order no person shall, except upon the

- **£** vehicle is wholly within the loading bay AND in those cases where special provision is made is identified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 3A to this Order, in accordance with those provisions. Every vehicle using a loading bay shall so stand so that every part of the

Parking Places

- 88 (1) The areas of highway identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 7 to this Order are hereby designated to be used as parking places. subject to the provisions of this Order.
- Each parking place identified within the individual plans detailed in Schedule 7 to this order and authorised under paragraph (1) of this Article may be used for the leaving of motor vehicles and motor cycles of such class as specified

within the individual plans detailed in that Schedule on such days and during such hours as identified.

- (3) The limits of each parking place (restricted) bay shall be indicated, by the Council, on the highway by the appropriate traffic signs and road markings.
- (4) Save as provided in Article 22 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, or civil enforcement officer, cause or permit a motor vehicle or motor cycle to wait in a parking place, authorised under paragraph (1) of this Article, for a period exceeding the maximum stay specified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 7 of this Order, or to return within the period also specified on those plans.
- B. Amendments throughout the Order referred to in Article 2 above to include reference to the amended Articles shown above.

SCHEDULES

Plans EH112, EH113, EH114, EH115, EH116 and EI115 have been amended to reflect the changes to those restrictions noted in Article 3 above. Where these plans are referenced in the Schedules to the Order described in Article 2 above, new plans bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order have been inserted.

Saving

- 1. In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- 2. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
