

**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM
(VARIOUS SCHOOLS, NORTH DURHAM – DERWENTSIDE, CHESTER-LE-
STREET AND EASINGTON AREAS)
(NO STOPPING ON SCHOOL ENTRANCE MARKINGS)
ORDER 2009**

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

Part I

General

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Various Schools, North Durham – Derwentside, Chester-le-Street and Easington Areas) (No Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2009 and shall come into operation on 1st January 2010.

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"liveried vehicle" means a vehicle having a distinctive design and colour scheme used to distinguish a police, bridge brigade or ambulance vehicle'

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

Part II

Revocations

3. The following Orders are hereby amended:-

- a. The County Council of Durham (Prohibition of Stopping between 8.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday) (Various Schools Murton) Order 2001. Schedule 1, item 1 deleted. 2/112.

- d. The County Council of Durham (B1432/Unclassified Byron terrace, Seaham) (Prohibition of Waiting) (Prohibition of Stopping on School Entrance Markings) Order 2006. Schedule 2 deleted. 2/138.
- e. The County Council of Durham (Various Roads, Peterlee Town Centre) (Prohibition of Waiting with Prohibition of Loading/Unloading and Prohibition of Stopping and Amendment) Order 2002. Schedule 2 deleted. 2/144.

Part III

No Stopping on School Entrance Markings

4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to stop (a) between the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Friday on the lengths of road specified in Schedules 1,2 and 4 to this Order and (b) between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 9.00 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. and 4.00 p.m. Monday to Friday on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
5. (1) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to any liveried vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
- (2) Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to anything done in accordance with any restrictions or requirements indicated by traffic signs placed on the roads by or on behalf of Durham Constabulary.
- (3) The vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets in the service of a universal service provider.

Part IV

Saving

6. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of THIS Order shall prevail.

7. The restrictions and prohibitions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

Schedule 1
No Stopping on School Entrance Markings – Derwentside Area
Monday-Friday 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m.

Castleside Primary School, Moorland Crescent, Castleside (west side of road):

- from a point 12m south of the centre line of Castleside Primary School access road in a northerly direction for a distance of 25.56m

The Grove St. Pius Xth RC Infant and Junior School, Thornfield Road, The Grove (west, south west side of road):

- from a point 23.0m south of the centre line of Thornfield Road (running north east to south west) in a northerly then north westerly direction for a distance of 43.56m

The Grove Primary School, Oakfield Lane, The Grove (east side of road):

- from a point 5.1m south of the centre line with The Grove Primary School access road in a northerly direction for a distance of 43.56m
- from a point 38.46m north of the centre line with The Grove Primary School access road in a northerly direction for a distance of 31.56m

Delves Lane Junior, infant and Nursery Schools, Delves Lane (south west side of road):

- from a point 7m south west of the centre line of Delves Lane in a north easterly then north westerly direction for a distance of 43.56m
- from a point 42.56m north west of the centre line of Lea Side in a north westerly then direction for a distance of 43.56m

Lanchester All Saints RC Primary School, Kitswell Road, Lanchester (south west side of road):

- from a point 1.4m north west of the centre line of Millfield in a south easterly direction for a distance of 31.56m
- from a point 30.26m north east of the centre line of Millfield in a south easterly direction for a distance of 31.56m

Langley Park Primary School, Front Street/May Terrace, Langley Park:

- (west/north side of the road) – from a point 15m north of the centre line of May Terrace in a southerly then westerly direction for a distance of 25.56m
- (west/south side of the road) – from a point 15m south of the centre line of May Terrace in a northerly then westerly direction for a distance of 25.56m

Esh C of E (Aided) Primary School, Front Street, Esh (north side of road):

- from a point 10m west of the centre line of Hall Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 25.56m

Leadgate Junior School, Alder Grove, Leadgate:

- (west/ north/ north-east then north side of road) – from the centre line of the access road leading into Leadgate Junior School in a northerly then easterly then south easterly then easterly direction for a distance of 25.56m
- (west/ south/ south-east then south side of road) – from the centre line of the access road leading into Leadgate Junior School in a Southerly then Easterly then North Easterly then Easterly direction for a distance of 25.56m

Our Lady and St. Josephs RC Primary School, St Ives Road, Leadgate (south east side of road):

- from a point 3.6m north of the centre line of the rear of St. Ives Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 43.56m
- from a point 47.26m north east of the centre line of the rear of St. Ives Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 43.56m

Leadgate County Infant School, West Street, Leadgate (south west side of road):

- from a point 12.1m south east of the centre line of Baker Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 43.56m
- from a point 55.76m south east of the centre line of Baker Street in a south easterly direction for a distance of 43.56m

Ebchester C of E Primary School, Shaw Lane, Ebchester:

- (south/south easterly side of road) – from a point 10.8m west of the centre line of the access road into Ebchester C of E Primary School in an easterly then south easterly direction for a distance of 37.56m
- (north/north west side of road) – from a point 14.2m west of the centre line of the access road into Ebchester C of E Primary School in an easterly then north easterly direction for a distance of 37.56m

Bishop Ian Ramsey School, Manor Road, Medomsley (north west side of road):

- from a point 52.1m north east of the centre line of Hunters Close in a north easterly direction for a distance of 25.56m
- from a point 77.76m north east of the centre line of Hunters Close in a north easterly direction for a distance of 37.56m

Dipton Colliery Primary School, Front Street, Dipton (north west side of road):

- from a point 67.0m south west of the centre line of Co-Operative Terrace in a south westerly direction for a distance of 24.56m

Dipton St Patricks RC Primary School, North Road, Dipton (west side of road):

- from a point 6.2m south of the centre line of Bradley Lodge Drive in a southerly direction for a distance of 37.56m
- from a point 43.86m south of the centre line of Bradley Lodge Drive in a southerly direction for a distance of 37.56m.

Greencroft Business and Enterprise Community School, Blackett Street, Greencroft

(south east side of road):

- from a point 15.0m north east of the centre line of the access road into Greencroft Business and Enterprise Community school in a south westerly direction for a distance of 31.56m

Annfield Plain Infants School, Northgate, Annfield Plain:

- (north west/south west side of road) – from a point 15m south of the centre line of Clavering Place in a south westerly, then south easterly direction for a distance of 25.56m
- (south east side of road) – from a point 22.6m north east of the centre line of Northgate Side in a south westerly direction for a distance of 25.56m

Annfield Plain Junior School, Un-named link road from Station Road to Mitchell Street, Annfield Plain (north west side of road):

- from a point 23m south west of the centre line of the back of Mitchell Street in a south westerly direction for a distance of 31.56m

Harelaw School, East View, Harelaw (east side of road):

- from a point 29.9m south of the centre line of Cemetary Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 25.56m
- from a point 70.46m south of the centre line of Cemetary Road in a southerly direction for a distance of 31.56m

Beamish Primary School and Nursery Unit, Gladstone Street, No Place, Stanley (east side of road):

- from a point 9.5m south of its junction line with Gladstone Street (north side of the road) in a southerly direction for a distance of 37.56m

Shield Row Primary School, Pelaw Avenue, Stanley (east side of road):

- from a point 23.56m north of the centre line of Ryton Crescent in a southerly direction for a distance of 43.56m

East Stanley County School, Noel Street, Stanley (west/south side of road):

- from a point 15.0m south of the junction line with Chester Road in a southerly then easterly direction for a distance of 25.56m

Tanfield Comprehensive School, Good Street, Tanfield Lea (south west side of road):

- from a point 98.3m north west of the centre line of Good Street(side) in a north westerly direction for a distance of 25.56m
- from a point 146.26m north west of the centre line of Good Street(side) in a north westerly direction for a distance of 25.56m

South Stanley Infants and Junior School, Tyne Road East, Stanley (west side of road):

- from a point 3.9m south of the centre line of Tweed Terrace in a south direction for a distance of 43.56m
- from a point 8.2m north of the centre line of Avon Road in a south direction for a distance of 31.56m

Oxhill Nursery, (unnamed road), Stanley (east side of road):
