

**THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM
(PRINCESS ROAD PRIMARY SCHOOL, SEAHAM)
(TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)
ORDER 2009**

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

Part I

General

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Princess Road Primary School, Seaham) (Traffic Management) Order 2009 and shall come into operation on 16 November 2009.

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Person's (Badge's for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended);

"disabled person's parking disc" means a device which:

- (a) is 125 millimetres square coloured blue, if issued on or after 1 April 2000, or orange if issued before that date
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter hour during which a period of waiting began.

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"liveried vehicle" a distinctive design and colour scheme used on vehicle to distinguish a police, fire or ambulance service vehicle.

"relevant position" means:-

- (i) in the case of a disabled person's badge;
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited thereon; or

- (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position in the vehicle so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from outside the vehicle; and
- (ii) in respect of a disabled person's parking disc:-
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel the badge is exhibited thereon; or
 - (b) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

"universal service provider" has the same meaning as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

Part II

Prohibition of Waiting between the hours of 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday

3. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait Monday to Saturday between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads detailed in Schedule 1 to this Order.

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

4. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Prohibition of Loading/unloading At Any Time

5. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on any of the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order for the purposes of enabling goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle.

No Stopping on School Entrance Markings between the hours of 8.00a.m and 6.00p.m Monday to Saturday

6. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or stop Monday to Saturday between the

less than one hour from the previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road, on the same day.

- (3) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order for so long as may be necessary to enable the picking up or setting down of passengers;
- (4) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of roads or sides of lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 1 to this Order for so long as may be necessary to load goods on to or unload goods from the vehicle.

Part IV

Saving

8. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of THIS Order shall prevail.
9. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

Schedule 1

Prohibition of Waiting between the hours of 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday

Location	Description	Side of road
1. Unnamed road between Princess Road and Springfield Crescent to the south of the new Primary and Nursery School	From a point 4m west of the centreline of Queen Street for a distance of 86m in a westerly direction	South
2. Unnamed road between Princess Road and Queen Street	From a point 10m from its junction with Princess Road for a distance of 48m in a westerly direction	North

Schedule 2

Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time & Prohibition of Loading/Unloading At Any Time

Location	Description	Side of road
3. Unnamed road between Princess Road and Springfield Crescent to the south of the new Primary and Nursery School.	From its junction with Princess Road for a distance of 10m in a westerly direction.	Both sides of road
4. Princess Road	From a point 16m south of the centreline of the unnamed road between Princess Road and Springfield Crescent for a distance of 32m in a northerly direction.	West
5. Princess Road	From a point 16m south off the centreline of the unnamed road between Princess Road and Queen Street for a distance of 32m in a northerly direction.	West
6. The unnamed road between Princess Road and Queen Street	From its junction with Princess Road for a distance of 10m in a westerly direction.	Both sides of road

Schedule 3

No Stopping on School Entrance Markings between the hours of 8.00a.m to 6.00p.m Monday to Saturday

Location	Description	Side of road
7. Unnamed road between Princess Road and Springfield Crescent to the south of the new Primary and Nursery School	From a point 86m from its junction with Princess Road for a distance of 57m in a westerly direction.	North

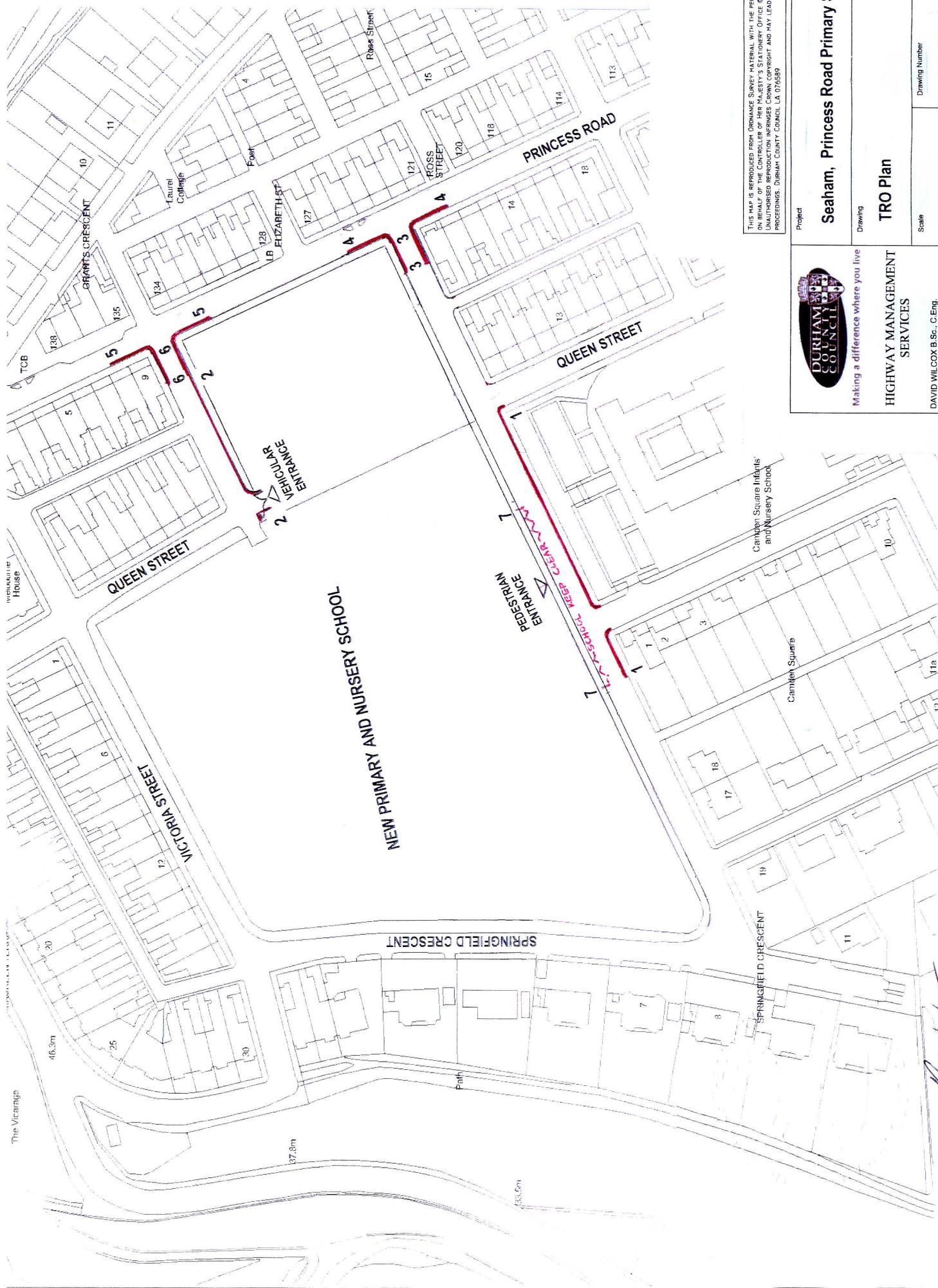
