THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (CASTLESIDE, ALLENSFORD AND MOORSIDE) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2011

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part 1
