THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (CONSETT) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PROHIBITION OF LOADING/UNLOADING) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2011

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part 1

General

 This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Consett) (Prohibition & Restriction of Waiting and Prohibition of Loading/Unloading) (Amendment) Order 2011 and shall come into operation on 1 December 2011.

Part II

Amendments

 The following amendments have been made to The County Council of Durham (Consett) (Prohibition & Restriction of Waiting and Prohibition of Loading/ Unloading)
 Order 2010:

Part I

Article 2 - Interpretation

(i) The following have been inserted:

"civil enforcement officer" means a person pursuant to the provisions of Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle parked in a parking place means the person driving or riding the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"enforcement authority" means the County Council of Durham.

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use in the carriage of goods or burden of any description and which has an unladen weight not exceeding 7.5 tonnes and is not drawing a trailer;

"parking bay" means an area of a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a motor vehicle and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place or by traffic signs;

"parking contravention" has the same meaning assigned to it by Section 73 and Part 1 of Schedule 7 to the Traffic management Act 2004 and "The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007".

"penalty charge" means a charge pursuant to the provisions of Section 77 of the Traffic management Act 2004; and "The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007";

"penalty charge notice" means a notice issued by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004; and

"The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007";

"permit" means a permit and a "valid permit" issued under the provisions of Article 3 of this Order;

- "permit holder" means a person to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of Article 7 of this Order;
- (ii) The definition for "taxi" has been removed from Article 2 (Interpretation).

Article 3 - Revocation

(a) The following order has been revoked in part:

The County Council of Durham (Consett) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Prohibition of Loading./Unloading) Order 2010 – plan references CQ169, CR169, CQ171, CP170, CR170 and CQ170 dated 29.7.10.

(b) The following order has been revoked in full:

The County of Durham (Unclassified Arc Street / Green Street. Consett) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1994

Part III

Articles 4 and 5

(a) Reference to Article 16 has been removed and replaced with Article 12.

(b) The words "or civil enforcement officer" have been inserted after enforcement officer.

The existing Articles 6 to 10 inclusive have been removed.

Part IV

Article 11 has been renumbered to Article 6

(i) The heading of the revised **Article 6** has been amended to read:

Parking Places

- (a) 8am 6pm 1 hour no return 20 mins
- (b) 8am 6pm 1 hour no return 3 hours
- (ii) In sub articles 1-5 inclusive reference to Schedule 8 has been removed and replaced with reference to Schedules 3 and 4.

A new Article 7 has been inserted which reads:

Parking Places - Permit Holders Only

- (1) The areas of highway identified in Schedule 7 to this Order are hereby designated as parking places.
- (2) Each parking place specified in Schedule 7 to this order, designated under paragraph (1) of this Article may be used for the leaving of motor vehicles and motor cycles on such days and during such hours as identified in the Masterplan and within the individual plan detailed in Schedule 7 to this Order.

- (3) Each parking place specified in Schedule 7 to this order, designated under paragraph (1) of this Article may be used, on such days and during such hours as identified in the Masterplan and within the individual plan detailed in Schedule 7, only by vehicles which display a valid permit.
- (4) The limits of each parking place and of each parking bay shall be indicated by the Council, on the carriageway by the appropriate traffic signs and the maximum number of parking bays are identified in the Masterplan and within the individual plan detailed in Schedule 7 to this Order.
- (5) The driver of a motor vehicle or a rider of a motor cycle shall not permit it to enter or wait in a parking place, authorised by paragraph (1) of this Article, for a period exceeding the maximum stay identified in the Masterplan and within the individual plan detailed in Schedule 7 or to return within the period also specified that plan.

The existing Article 12 has been renumbered to Article 8 and amended as follows:

(i) The heading of the Article has been amended to read:

Disabled Badge Holders:

- (a) Disabled Badge Holders Only At Any Time
- (b) Disabled Badge Holders 3 hour limit
- (ii) Reference in sub articles (1), (2) and (3) to Schedules 9 and 10 have been removed and reference to Schedules 5 and 6 inserted.

The existing Article 13 has been renumbered to Article 9 and amended as follows:

- (i) The heading of the Article has been amended to read:
 - Loading Bays Monday to Saturday 8am-6pm
- (ii) Reference to Schedules 11 and 12 have been removed and reference to Schedule 8 inserted in sub Articles (1), (2) and (4).
- (iii) Reference to Article 16 in sub Article 2 has been removed and reference to Article 12 inserted.

The existing Article 14 has been renumbered to Article 10 and amended as follows:

Reference in sub Article (1) to Articles 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 have been removed and reference to Articles 6, 7, 8 and 9 inserted.

The existing Article 15 has been renumbered to Article 11.

The existing Article 16 has been renumbered to Article 12 and amended as follows:

- (i) Sub Articles 1 and 2 reference to Articles 10, 11, 12 and 13 have been removed.
- (ii) Sub Article 3 reference to Articles 7, 8, 9 and 10 have been removed.
- (iii) Sub Article 4 Reference to Article 13 has been removed and reference to Articles 4, 6, 7, 8 and 9 inserted.

(iv) Sub Article 4 appears numbered twice, the second sub Article (4) has therefore been renumbered to sub article (5). Reference to Articles 7,8,9,10,11 and 12 have been removed.

Part VI

The existing Articles numbered 17 and 18 have been renumbered as 13 and 14 respectively.

- 4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
