# THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (EASINGTON, EASINGTON COLLIERY AND SOUTH HETTON) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LOADING/UNLOADING) ORDER 2010 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2021

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act"); Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

#### Part I

#### 1. General

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Easington, Easington Colliery and South Hetton) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading/Unloading) Order 2010 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2017 and shall come into operation on the 5th Day of July 2021.

#### Part II

#### 2. Amendments

The following amendments apply to:

The County Council of Durham (Easington, Easington Colliery and South Hetton)
 (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading/Unloading) Order 2010

#### 3. Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order however the plans should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

1.To introduce new restriction 'No Stopping, Monday-Friday, 8am-6pm' on entrance markings on the northern side of Crawlaw road from a point adjacent to the Electrical Sub Station for 125 metres in westerly direction to its west-most point.

All other restrictions remain unchanged

#### 4. Articles

1. New article No.12 has been inserted which reads:

### Part V PROHIBITION OF STOPPING

Prohibition of Stopping on Entrance Markings between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Friday

- (1) The areas of highway identified within the individual plan(s) detailed in Schedule 5 to this Order is hereby designated as Prohibition of Stopping on Entrance Markings, subject to the provisions of this Order.
- (2) Save as provided in Article 13 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer cause or permit any

vehicle to stop or wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Monday to Friday on any of the lengths of roads identified within the individual location plans detailed in Schedule 5 to this Order

2. All other Articles throughout the Order impacted by the above changes have been renumbered according.

#### 5. Schedules

1. A new Schedule has been inserted which reads

## Schedule 5 No Stopping on entrance markings between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Friday

In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
