THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (DURHAM CITY PARK AND RIDE SITES) ORDER 2005 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2020

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 33, 34 & 35 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

General

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Off Street Parking Places) (Durham City Park and Ride Sites) Order 2005 (Amendment No 1) Order 2020 and shall come into operation on 24th Day of September 2020.

Purpose of Amendments

2. Article 7 shall be revoked in its entirety and in its place insertion of the following:-

"All drivers and their vehicle passengers are not permitted to park without paying for **AND** using the park and ride bus service for their onward Journey. The onward journey must take place from the park and ride service site at which the driver's vehicle has been parked"

Saving

- 3. In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
 - 4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
