(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STOPPING, PARKING PLACES AND DISABLED PARKING) ORDER 2011 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2021

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 & 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. GENERAL

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Sedgefield) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Stopping, Parking Places and Disabled Parking) Order 2011 (Amendment No. 1) Order and 2021 and shall come into operation on 14th Day of February 2022.

2. AMENDMENTS

The under-noted amendments have been made to the following Order:

The County Council of Durham (Sedgefield) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Stopping, Parking Places and Disabled Parking) Order 2011

Purpose of Amendments

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

To introduce No Waiting At Any Time restrictions on:

- a. The junction of St Edmunds Green and Butterwick road extending 11 metres northeast and 7 metres south-west along Butterwick road – EP89 refers
- b. Butterwick Road, opposite the junction for St Edmunds Green, starting at a point 15 metres south-west of the junction for a length of 69 metres in a north-easterly direction EP89 refers
- c. The junction of St Edmunds Green and Butterwick road extending 9 metres northeast and 13 metres south-west along Butterwick road EP89 and EP90 refers.
- d. From the access for Sedgefield Community College south on either side of the road, around the junction onto Butterwick Road for 9 metres EP90 and EQ90 refers.
- e. On both sides of Dunelm Court in a south-easterly direction for 7 metres from its junction with Station Road EO88 refers.
- f. On the south-eastern side of Station road from a point 10 metres south west of its junction with Dunelm Court in a north-westerly direction for 25 metres EO88 refers.

SCHEDULES

Plans EO88 and EP89 have been amended to reflect the changes to those restrictions noted in Article 2 above. Where these plans are referenced in the Schedules to the Order described in Article 2 above, new plans EP90 and EQ90 bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order have been inserted.

Saving

- In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
