THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (THIRD STREET, HORDEN) (ONE WAY & NO ENTRY) (EXPERIMENTAL) ORDER 2020

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

Part I

General

 This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Third Street, Horden) (One Way & No Entry) (Experimental) Order 2020 and shall come into operation on day 19th day of June 2020

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"enforcement officer" means a uniformed police officer, police community support officer or any subsequent designation of these officers;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act;

"one-way street" means a highway in which vehicles are prohibited at all times from proceeding in any other than one direction.

"pedal cycle" means a cycle whose motive power is provided solely by the legs of its rider or riders or which complies with the requirements specified in Regulation 4 of the Electrically Assisted Pedal Cycles Regulations 1983;

Part II

One Way

3. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any motor vehicle or pedal cycle to proceed on the length of road specified in the Schedule 1 to this Order, in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road in the said Schedule.

No Entry

4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of an enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle, including pedal cycles, to enter the road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Part III

Exemptions

5. (1) Nothing in Article 3 & 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on any of the lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

- (a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely
 - (i) building, demolition or excavation;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said roads:
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or maintenance in or in land adjacent to the said lengths of roads of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (b) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road to be used in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory duties;
- (2) Nothing in Articles 3 & 5 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue service or ambulance purposes on emergency call.

Part IV

Saving

- 6. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of THIS Order shall prevail.
- 7. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
