# The County Council of Durham (Durham City (North West)) (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2012 (Amendment No.1) Order 2021

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

#### General

1. This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Durham City (North West)) (Parking and Waiting Restrictions) Order 2012 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 2021.

## **Amendments**

2. The under-noted amendments have been made to the following Orders:

## **Purpose of Amendments**

The following brief synopsis of amendments should be viewed in conjunction with the plans identified within the Schedules to the above Order, however the plan(s) should prevail in the event of any discrepancy:

To amend the existing No Waiting and No Loading/Unloading at Any time Restriction to Disabled Badge Holders only 3 hours No return within 4 hours:

The west side of Freemans Place from a point 11 metres south of the entrance to Durham Sixth Form heading in a southerly direction for 26 metres - plan DY140 refers.

To amend the existing No Waiting and No Loading/Unloading at Any time Restriction to Loading Only Mon-Sat 8am-6pm:

The west side of Freemans Place from a point opposite the entrance to Durham Sixth Form heading in a northerly direction for 25 metres – plan DY140 refers.

### 3. Schedules

Plan DY140 has been amended to reflect the changes to those restrictions noted in Article 2 above. Where these plans are referenced in the Schedules to the Order described in Article 2 above, new plans bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order have been inserted.

## Saving

- 3. In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
- 4. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
