The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 & 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. GENERAL

This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (Cotherstone) (Prohibition of Stopping) Order 2011 (Amendment No.1) Order 2022 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of June 2022...

To amend the existing No stopping (Mon-Fri 8am-6pm) on entrance markings

Extending the existing restriction from a point on the north side of Farthings House in a southerly direction for 15 metres – plan BX54 refers

Plan BX54 have been amended to reflect the changes to the restriction noted in Article 2 above. Where the plan is referenced in the Schedule to the Order described in Article 2 above, a new plan bearing the seal date as at the date of this Amendment Order has been inserted.

4. In so for as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.

5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
