# THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF DURHAM (WEST AUCKLAND) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND STOPPING) ORDER 2012 (AMENDMENT NO. 1) ORDER 2015

The County Council of Durham ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 & 4, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act"); Part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

#### Part I

#### General

 This Order may be cited as The County Council of Durham (West Auckland) (Prohibition of Walting and Stopping) Order 2012 (Amendment No. 1) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March 2016.

"disabled person's badge" and "disabled person's parking disc" have the same meaning as in the Disabled Person's (Badge's for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended);

"relevant position" has the same meaning as defined by The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
