

EAST DEVON DISTRICT COUNCIL (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) AMENDMENT ORDER NO 1 2008

The District Council of East Devon in the County of Devon (hereinafter called "the Counci!") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and under the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of Devon County Council in accordance with section 39(3) of the 1984 Act and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Devon and Cornwall Constabulary in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

Commencement and Citation

- 1 This Order shall come into operation on the 28th day of October 2008 and may be cited as the East Devon District Council (Civil Enforcement Off-Street Parking Places) Amendment Order No 1 2008.
- 2 This Order may be cited as "The East Devon District Council (Off Street Parking Places)
 Amendment Order No 1 2008
- 3 The Order shall be supplementary to The East Devon District Council (Civil Enforcement Off Street Parking Places) Order 2008 (hereinafter referred to as "the 2008 Order")

ADDITIONS AND AMENDMENTS

4 The 2008 Order shall be amended as follows:

- (a) There shall be included in the car parks referred to in the 2008 Order and added to the definition of "Parking Place" contained in the 2008 Order the area of land shown edged blue on the plan annexed hereto and known as the Townsend Coach Park Beer Devon. The Schedule attached hereto shall be added to the Schedules contained in the 2008 Order.
- (b) The Classes of Vehicles permitted to use the spaces in the Townsend Coach Park Beer Devon and other conditions of use are set out in the said Schedule.
- (c) Any person using the Townsend Coach Park Beer Devon in accordance with the authorised conditions of use set out in the Schedule hereto and the 2008 Order shall upon leaving the Vehicle (as defined in the 2008 Order) in the Townsend Coach Park Beer pay the appropriate charge in accordance with the scale of current charges as specified in the Schedule to this Order unless they are the holder of a valid Parking


Permit (as defined in the 2008 Order) which has been issued by East Devon District Council for the particular Vehicle brought into the said Townsend Coach Park Beer and in respect of Townsend Coach Park Beer and they display the Parking Permit in, the Relevant Place (as defined in the 2008 Order) on the Vehicle

(d) All of the definitions contained in the 2008 Order and all of the terms provisions and conditions contained or referred to in the 2008 Order (including (but without prejudice to the generality of the provisions hereof) the provisions for the civil enforcement of traffic offences) shall apply to Townsend Coach Park Beer Devon

SAVE AS AFORESAID THE 2008 Order shall remain in full force and effect
