STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

THE HERTFORDSHIRE (STATION ROAD, WARE) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING EXCEPT TAXIS) ORDER 2012

The Hertfordshire County Council is undertaking enhancements to the area outside Ware Railway Station and are proposing to install a new taxi rank on the southern side of Station Road, Ware.

The proposal will comprise of -

• The introduction of a prohibition of stopping and waiting except taxis bay, effective between the hours of 5.00am to 11.00pm on any day, in Station Road, Ware, outside Ware Railway Station.

These measures are promoted in order to provide commuters with safe access to the taxi service and allow pedestrians full use of the footway whilst maintaining vehicular traffic flow on Station Road.

As part of the taxi rank installation, dropped kerbs, seating and wider footways will also be installed. Lighting columns will be upgraded and road markings refreshed.

It therefore appears to the Highway Authority having considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 that it is necessary and expedient to make the Order in the interests of highway safety for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road and for preventing the likelihood of such danger arising and to facilitate the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians).

All of the proposed measures have been subject to consultation with, local and County Councillors representing the area and East Herts District Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, Hertfordshire County Council Passenger Transport Unit and local residents have also been consulted.

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Station Road, Ware) (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting Except Taxis) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on Monday 2 September 2013.
- Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a taxi, to stop or wait between the hours of 5.00am to 11.00pm on any day in that length of Station Road, Ware as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
 - In this Order the expression 'Taxi' shall have the meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (SI 2002/3113)
- 3(1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the length of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to
 - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
 - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform; or with permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by East Hertfordshire District Council.
 - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
 - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
 - (e) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this Article -

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

- (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are -
 - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
 - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
 - (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
 - (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications

apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.

- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. The provisions of the following Order are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order –

6. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
