# THE HERTFORDSHIRE (VARIOUS ROADS, BUNTINGFORD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING ON SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS) ORDER 2007

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Various Roads, Buntingford)
  (Prohibition of Stopping and Waiting on School Keep Clear Markings) Order 2007"
  and shall come into operation on Monday 28 April 2008.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop or wait between the hours of 8.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday during school term time on the 'school keep clear' markings in those lengths of road in Buntingford specified in the Schedule to this Order.

In this Article -

"school term time" has the meaning – as those days of the year which have been determined by the education authority as school days in accordance with the provisions of Section 32 of The Education Act 2002.

- 3.(1) Nothing in Article 2 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article (which said lengths of road is referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to
  - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
  - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of -
    - (i) a police officer in uniform;
    - (ii) a Civil Enforcement Officer appointed by East Hertfordshire District Council and as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004.
  - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
  - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
  - (e) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this Article -

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000.

(2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are -

- (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
- (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
- (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
- (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

from a point 3.5 metres south east of a point in line with the north west boundary of 42 Norfolk Road south eastwards for approximately 51 metres to a point 2.5 metres north west of a point in line with the south

east boundary of 27 Norfolk Road.

Monks Walk (south side)

from a point 30 metres west of a point in line with the boundary between 149 and 151 Monks Walk eastwards for approximately 51 metres to a point 5 metres west of a point in line with the east boundary of 151 Monks Walk

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

#### STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING

# THE HERTFORDSHIRE (THE CAUSEWAY, BOWLING GREEN LANE and MONKS WALK, BUNTINGFORD) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND WAITING ON SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR MARKINGS) ORDER 2007

The Hertfordshire County Council is currently preparing schemes to encourage pupils and parents to consider their ways of travelling to and from school and where appropriate to implement measures to improve road safety on roads in the vicinity of schools in particular for the benefit of school pupils.

Such schemes are being prepared for a number of schools in Buntingford.

The aim of the scheme is to introduce the following restrictions:-

 No stopping or waiting on 'School Keep Clear' markings between 8.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Friday during school term time restriction.

These restrictions will render current advisory only markings as enforceable and where no such markings have been provided, implement such restrictions.

It is intended that these restrictions will improve road safety by keeping the roads in the vicinity of school entrances free from parking, allowing for better crossing and egress visibility.

All of the proposed measures have been subject to consultation with, local and County Councillors representing the area and East Herts District Council. The local Police, Ambulance and Fire & Rescue Services, local residents and affected schools have also been consulted.
