#### **THE HERTFORDSHIRE (TAMWORTH ROAD, HERTFORD) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (No.2) ORDER 2024**

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”), and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The Hertfordshire (Tamworth Road, Hertford) (Restriction of Waiting) (No.2) Order 2024” and shall come into effect on Monday 18 August 2025.
2. The Hertfordshire (Tamworth Road, Hertford) (Restriction of Waiting) (No.2) Order 2024 Plan numbered **EH01224P**, inclusive of its key, is incorporated into this Order, as listed in the Schedule to this Order.
3. **Interpretation –**  
In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them;  
“disabled person’s vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;  
“disabled person’s badge” has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;  
“parking disc” has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;  
“relevant position” has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;  
“postal packet” shall bear the same meaning as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011;  
“provision of a universal postal Service” shall bear the same meaning as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011;  
“universal service provider” shall bear the same meaning as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.
4. Save as provided in Articles 5, 6 and 7 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait on areas of road or sides of the road as shown on plan **EH01224P**, where waiting is not allowed as identified and shown on the waiting restrictions plan and the key thereof.
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order applies in relation to -
  - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
  - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform, or with permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by East Hertfordshire District Council.
  - (c) a vehicle which is being used for one or more of the following purposes and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the lengths of road restricted by that Article;
    - (i) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;

- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
  - (iv) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
  - (v) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- (d) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is waiting only for long as is reasonably necessary to enable postal packets to be delivered or collected.
6. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by that Article, as identified on plan **EH01224P**, so as to render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary –
- (a) to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area; or
  - (b) to enable a passenger to board or alight and to load and unload any luggage.
7. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait at any time in the lengths of road restricted by that Article for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
8. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
9. The provisions of the following Orders are hereby revoked only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order:
- The East Hertfordshire District Council (Control of Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2020  
The Hertfordshire (Tamworth Road, Hertford) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2024
10. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.





NOTICE is given that the Hertfordshire County Council has made an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (1984 Act) to introduce new waiting restrictions on Tamworth Road, Hertford as specified in the Schedule to this Notice. The Order will come into effect on Monday 18 August 2025.
