On the 30th August 2018 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made this Order which will be operative from the 30th August 2018 the effect of which will be to change the current Short Stay Pay and Display Zone known as Albion Terrace, Royal Crescent and Carlisle Road, Bridlington from a Short Stay Pay and Display Zone (2 hours maximum stay with no return within 1 hour) to a Medium Stay Pay and Display Zone (4 hours maximum stay with no return within 1 hour). The Pay and Display charges will apply all days from 8am to 6pm at charging rates of 60 pence for 1 hour, £1.80 for 2 hours, £3.00 for 3 hours and £3.90 for up to 4 hours.
