

 - (a) To introduce No Waiting and No Loading at Any Time on parts of Victoria Road, Driffield
 - (b) To introduce No Waiting at Any Time on parts of Church Street, on parts of Victoria Road, Driffield
 - (c) To introduce No Loading at Any Time on parts of Middle Street South, on parts of Market Place, parts of George Street and parts of Cranwell Road, Driffield

(d) To introduce disabled parking bays for use Monday to Saturday for 2 hours with no return within 1 hour on parts of Middle Street South, Driffield

(e) To introduce a Loading Only Bay on part of Middle Street South, part of Market Place and part of Cranwell Road, Driffield

(f) To remove the existing Non-Mandatory School Keep Clear Markings on Victoria Road, Driffield

- (g) To introduce a disabled parking bay for 3 hours with no return within 3 hours on part of Cranwell Road, Driffield
