- 1. On the 30th August 2018 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made this Order which will be operative from the 30th August 2018 the effect of which will be to –
- (a) To introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on parts of Station Road, Elloughton Road, Jefferson Drive, Woodland Avenue, Springfield Avenue and Welton Road, Brough.

(b) To extend the No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on parts of Welton Road, Brough

(c) To introduce Resident Permit Holders only parking bays for use Monday to Saturday between 10am and 11am on parts of Station Road, Brough.

(d) To extend the existing No Waiting Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm on Station Road, Brough.

(e) To introduce School Keep Clear No Stopping from Monday to Friday between 8.15am and 9.15am and between 3pm and 4pm on part of Elloughton Road and Springfield Avenue, Brough.

(f) To introduce No Waiting Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm on parts of Elloughton Road, Brough.

(g) To introduce unrestricted parking bays on parts of Elloughton Road, Brough.

(h) To introduce No Waiting Monday to Friday between 8.15am and 9.15am and between 3pm and 4pm on parts of Springfield Avenue, Brough.

- (i) To introduce Limited Waiting parking bays for use Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm for 3 hours with no return within 1 hour on parts of Welton Road, Brough.
- 2. A copy of the Order and relevant plan may be examined during normal office hours at the Brough Customer Service Centre, Petuaria Centre, Centurion Way, Brough, HU15 1AY, Beverley Customer Service Centre, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA. (Ref MG/77326)
- 3. If you wish to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 30th August 2018 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
