The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") as amended and in pursuance of powers granted by the Secretary of State under Section 74 and Part 2 of Schedule 8 and under Paragraph 8 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 2004") as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 27th day of December 2018 and may be cited as The East Riding of Yorkshire Council(On Street Parking Places)(Civil Enforcement)(Consolidation)(Amendment No.23)) (Armstrong Way and Flemingate Court, Beverley)Order 2018.
2. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (On Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Consolidation) Order 2017 is hereby amended to the following extent:
 - (a) The Plan Tile References DN121 and DO121 specified in Schedule 1 (Parkmap Schedule 24.01) to this Order are hereby revoked and:
 - (b) The Plan Tile Reference DN121A and DO121A specified in Schedule 2 (Parkmap Schedule 25.01) to this Order are hereby inserted.



1. On the 27 December 2018 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made this Order which will be operative from the 27 December 2018 the effect of which will be to

- (a) To introduce a shared use bay on part of Armstrong Way, Beverley for use as follows:-
 - i) Goods Vehicles loading only between 6am and noon all days
 - ii) No Stopping except taxis between noon and 6am all days
- (b) To introduce a shared use bay on part of Armstrong Way, Beverley for use as follows:-
 - i) Goods Vehicles loading only between 6am and noon all days
 - ii) Limited Waiting between noon and 6am all days for 20 minutes with no return within the hour
- (c) To introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on part of Flemingate Court, Beverley

2. A copy of the Order and relevant plan may be examined during normal office hours at the Beverley Customer Service Centre, Cross Street, Beverley, HU17 9BA (Ref CN/77557)

3. If you wish to question the validity of this Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the 27th December 2018 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
