## THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL (HAILGATE, HOWDEN) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2013

The East Riding of Yorkshire Council has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to proceed stop or park along the parking bays at Hailgate, Howden, outside numbers 67 and 78.

The reason for the closure is to enable the proposed building works to be carried out and completed in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public.

The road will be open at all times to pedestrians and for access to properties directly affected by the closure and for the emergency services.

The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (On Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2012 is hereby suspended for the areas listed for the duration of this Order. The Order will commence on 19th August 2013, and continue in force for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the works which it is proposed to carry out have been completed, whichever is the earlier. If the works are not completed within eighteen months the Order may be extended for a longer period with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport.
