ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (Lewes District) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2004 (as amended) (Amendment No.1) (Part 1) Order 2011, Amendment Order 2013 No.1

East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1) and (2), and 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(2), 32, 35(1) and (3), 45, 49, 51, 52, 53 and 63A of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) ("the Act"), as amended, and sections 43, and 63 to 79 inclusive and Schedule 3 to the Road Traffic Act 1991(b), and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part II of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. When this order comes into effect, "The East Sussex (Lewes District) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2004 (as amended) (Amendment No.1) (Part 1) Order 2011" shall have the effect insofar as the following provisions (which are shown in italic) are amended, introduced or revoked:

(a) Amend article 4 to:

Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge, and a time clock (on which the driver or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in the lengths of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding one hour (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).

(b) In the Schedule - No Waiting At Any Time, the following are revoked:-

Seaford

Belgrave Road -

Northwest side

from a point 15 metres northeast of the eastern kerbline of Kimgsmead,

southwestwards for a distance of 37 metres.

Southeast side

from a point 15 metres northeast of the eastern kerbline of Kingsmead

southwestwards for a distance of 37 metres.

2. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (Lewes District) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2004 (as amended) (Amendment No.1) (Part 1) Order 2011 Amendment Order 2013 No.1" and shall come into operation on 3 September 2013.
