EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (Lewes District Prohibition of Waiting) Traffic Regulation Order 2010

East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. (1) This Order shall come into operation on 22 June 2010 and may be cited as The East Sussex (Lewes District Prohibition of Waiting) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2010and shall have the following provision:
- (a). In Schedule 1, Part A, Prohibition of Waiting, At Any Time, the following are omitted:-

Barcombe - 1.(a)(i); 1.(b)(i); 2.(a)(i); 3.(a)(i); 3.(b)(i); 3.(c)(i) and 3.(d)(i);

Ditchling -1.(a)(i); 2.(a)(i),(ii) and (iii); 2.(b)(i) and (ii); 4.(a)(i),(ii),(ii),(iv),(v) and (vi); 4.(b)(i),(ii) and (iii); 5.(a)(i); 5.(b)(i); 6.(a)(i),(ii),(ii),(iv),(v),(v) and (vii); 6.(b)(i),(ii) and (iii); 7.(a)(i); 7.(a)(i); 7.(a)(i); 7.(a)(i); and 7.(a)(i); 7.(a)(

Ringmer - 1.(b)(i); 7.(a)(i) and 7.(b)(i) and (ii)

(b). In Schedule 1, Part C, Prohibition of Waiting 8am to 6pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, the following are omitted:-

Barcombe - 1(a)(i); 2(a)(i) and 2(b)(i)and

Ringmer - 1.(a)(i) and (ii); and 2.(a)(i)

(c). In Schedules 3, Part F, 2 Hours in any Period of 2 Hours – 9am to 4pm on Mondays to Fridays, 1st September to 31st May, the following are omitted:-

Falmer – 1.(a)(i); 2(a)(i) and (ii); 2.(a)(i) and (ii); 2.(b)(i)(ii); 3.(a)(i) and (ii); 4.(a)(i); 5.(a)(i) and 6.(a)(i)

(d). In Schedule 1, Part A, Prohibition of Waiting, At Any Time, the following are included:-

Barcombe

- 1 High Street
- (a) West side
 - (i) from a point 4 metres south of the southern boundary of the entrance to Hillside Nurseries northwards, for a distance of 108.5 metres.

- (ii) from the northern building line of End Cottage northwards, for a distance of 6 metres.
 - (iii) from the northern building line of a property known as Brinkwells northwards, for a distance of 17 metres.

(b) East side

- (i) from a point 99 metres south of its junction with Barcombe Mills Road southwards, for a distance of 14.5 metres.
- (ii) from a point 104 metres south of its junction with Barcombe Mills Road southwards, for a distance of 14 metres.
- (iii) from a point 148 metres south of the junction with Barcombe Mills Road southwards, for a distance of 35 metres.
- (iv) from its junction with Barcombe Mills Road southwards, for a distance of 11 metres.

2. School Path

(a) South side

(i) from a point opposite the junction of School Hill with the northern side of School Path southwards into the High Street, east side, for a distance of 35.5 metres.

3. Weald View

(a) North side

(i) from its junction with the High Street eastwards, for a distance of 71 metres.

(b) South side

- (i) from its junction with the High Street eastwards, for a distance of 9.5 metres.
- (ii) from a point 47 metres from its junction with the High Street eastwards and southwards, for a distance of 71 metres.

(c) East side

(i) from a point 1.5 metres north of the southern boundary of property no 1. Weald View southwards, for a distance of 34 metres.

4. Barcombe Mills Road

(a) North side

(i) from its junction with the High Street eastwards, for a distance of 17 metres.

(b) South side

(i) from its junction with High Street eastwards, for a distance of 18 metres.

5. Grantham Bank

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with Barcombe Mills Road northwards, for a distance of 11.5 metres.

6. School Hill

(a) West side

(i) from its junction with the north side of School Path northwards, for a distance of 16 metres.

(b) East side

(i) from a point opposite a point 16 metres north of the junction of School Hill and the northern side of School Path southwards and south east, for a distance of 45 metres.

Ditchling

1. Dumbrells Court Road

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with North End east, for a distance of 7.5 metres.

2. East End Lane

(a) North side

- (i) from its junction with High Street eastwards to its junction with the eastern boundary of the property known as number 11 East End Lane, for a distance of 54.5 metres.
- (ii) from the western boundary of The Dymocks northwest for a distance of 10 metres
- (iii) from the eastern boundary of The Dymocks southeast for a distance of 10 metres.

(b) South Side

- (i) from a point 6.2 metres east of the eastern boundary of The Twitten westwards for a distance if 24 metres.
- (ii) from its junction with High Street eastwards to a point opposite the western building line of the property known as number 11 East End Lane, for a distance of 48 metres.

4. High Street

(a) East Side

- (i) from a point 1 metre north of the southern boundary of The Sandrock Inn in a southwards direction to the northern kerbline of Lewes Road, for a distance of 74 metres.
- (ii) from a point 1.5 metres south of the southern boundary of number 28 High Street in a northwards direction to the southern kerbline of East End Lane, for a distance of 40.4 metres.
- (iii) From its junction with East Gardens south to its junction with East End Lane, for a distance of 29 metres.

(b) West Side

- (i) from a point 6 metres north from the prolongation of the northern building line of number 45 High Street in a southwards direction, for a distance of 30 metres.
- (ii) from a point 39 metres south from the prolongation of the northern building line of number 45 High Street in a southwards direction to its junction with West Street, for a distance of 107.7 metres.

5. Lewes Road

(a) North Side

(i) from its junction with the High Street in an eastwards direction, for a distance of 199 metres

(b) South Side

- (ii) from the prolongation of the building line between number 2 and 4 Lewes Road in a westwards direction, for a distance of 22 metres.
- (ii) from the eastern boundary of number 12 Lewes Road in an eastwards direction, for a distance of 142.2 metres.

6. North End

(a) East Side

- from the northern kerbline of Dunbrells Court Road in a northwards direction, for a distance of 36 metres.
- (ii) from the southern kerbline of Dunbrells Court Road in a southwards direction, for a distance of 29 metres.
- (iii) from the southern building line of North Cottage in a northwards direction, for a distance of 61 metres.
- (iv) from the boundary of 38/40 North End in a northwards direction, for a distance of 46 metres.

(b) West Side

- (i) from a point opposite the northern boundary of number 44 North End in a northwards direction, for a distance of 123.5 metres.
- (ii) from the boundary of number 55 North End and Meadow Side in a northwards direction, for a distance of 71 metres.

7. South Street

(a) East Side

- (i) from the southern kerbline of Lewes Road in a southwards direction, for a distance of 24 metres.
- (ii) from the northern boundary of Emmanuel Chapel in a southwards direction, for a distance of 67 metres.

(b) West Side

- (i) from the southern kerbline of West Street in a southwards direction, for a distance of 27 metres.
- (ii) from a point opposite the northern boundary of Emmanel

Chapel in a southwards then south-westwards direction, for a distance of 69 metres

8. West Street

(a) South Side

(i) from its junction with South Stress in a westwards direction, for a distance of 47.2 metres.

(b) North Side

(i) from its junction with the High Street in a westwards direction, for a distance of 50.2 metres.

9. Beacon Road

(a) West Side

(i) from a point opposite the northern boundary of 2A Beacon Road in a northwards then westwards direction into Clayton Road, for a distance of 60.5 metres

Ringmer

7. Vicarage Way

(a) North side of the central island

(i) from the northern side of the central island (a the junction of vicarage Way with the Lewes Road) northwards, to a point 15 metres north of its junction with the northern kerbline of the slip road leading in from the Lewes Road.

(b) West side

(i) from the northern side of the entrance to Merton House in a southwards direction, for a distance of 49.5 metres.

(ii) from a point 60 metres south of the northern side of the entrance to Merton House in a southwards direction, for a distance of 8.5 metres.

9. Anchor Field

(a) South side

(i) from its junction with Springett Avenue, in a south-eastwards direction, for a distance of 66.5 metres.

10. Broyle Lane

(a) East side

(i) from its junction with The Broyle in a northwards direction, for a distance of 45.3 metres.

(b) West side

(i) from its junction with The Broyle in a northwards direction, for a distance of 84.5 metres.

11. Ballard Drive

(a) East side

(i) from the southerm building of number 1 Foxglove Close in a southwards direction, for a distance of 25 metres.

12. Foxglove Close

(a) Both sides

(i) from the eastern kerbline of Ballard Drive in an eastwards direction, for a distance of 8 metres.

13. Turnpike Close

(a) Both sides

(i) from the eastern kerbline of Ballards Drive in an eastwards direction, for a distance of 8 metres.

14. Millmead

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with Shepherds Way in a westwards direction, for a distance of 5 metres.

15. Shepherds Way

(a) West side

(i) from a point 5 metres south of the southern kerbline of Mill Mead in a northwards direction, for a distance of 15.5 metres.

16. Hayes Close

(a) Both sides

(i) from the eastern kerbline of Harvard Road in an eastwards direction, for a distance of 10 metres.

Saltdean

2. Longridge Avenue

(a) South-east side

- (i) from a point 15 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerbline of Rodmell Avenue south-westwards to a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Rodmell Avenue.
- (ii) from a point 15 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerbline of Oaklands Avenue south-westwards to a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Oaklands Avenue
- (iii) from a point 15 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerbline of Wicklands Avenue south-westwards to a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Crowborough Road.
- (iv) from its junction with the southern kerbline of Nutley Avenue, south-westwards, for a distance of 15 metres.
- (v) from a point 15 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerbline

of Lynwood Road south-westwards to a point 15 metres south-west of the south-western kerbline of Lynwood Road.

- (vi) from its junction with Marine Drive east-wards, for a distance of 28 metres.
- (vii) from its junction with Longridge Avenue south-eastwards, for a distance of 15 metres.
- (viii) from its junction with Nutley Avenue in a north-eastwards direction, for a distance of 15 metres.

3. Bevendean Avenue

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with the south-east side of Longridge Avenue eastwards, for a distance of 15 metres.

4. Crowborough Road

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with Longridge Avenue south-eastwards and southwards, for a distance of 15 metres.

5. Lynwood Road

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with Longridge Avenue south-eastwards, for a distance of 15 metres.

6. Nutley Avenue

(a) North-east side

(i) from its junction with Longridge Avenue in a south-east direction for 15 metres.

7. Oaklands Avenue

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with the south-east side of Longridge Avenue eastwards, for a distance of 15 metres.

8. Rodmell Avenue

(a) Both sides

(i) from its junction with the south-east side of Longridge Avenue eastwards, for a distance of 15 metres.

9. Wicklands Avenue

(a) Both sides

- (i) from its junction with the south-east side of Longridge Avenue, eastwards, for a distance of 15 metres.
- (e). In Schedule 1, Part C, Prohibition of Waiting, 8am to 6pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, the following are included:-

Ringmer

- 1. Anchor Field
- (a) North side
 - (i) from its junction with Springett Avenue south-eastwards to the western kerbline of Shelley Road.
 - (ii) from the eastern kerbline of Shelley road south then southeastwards, for a distance of 28 metres.
- (f). In Schedule 1, Part D, Prohibition of Waiting, 8am to 6pm Mondays to Fridays inclusive, the following are included:-

Barcombe

- 2. High Street
- (a) West side
 - (i) from a point 24.5 metres south of the southern boundary of Grange Road northwards, to the southern building line of Barcombe Village Hall.
 - (ii) from a point 18 metres north of the northern building line of Barcombe Village Hall northwards, for a distance of 21.5 metres.
- (b) East side
 - (i) from a point 11 metres south of its junction with Barcombe Mills Road southwards, for a distance of 55 metres.
- (g). In Schedule 3, Part E, Limited Time Prohibition of Waiting, 2 hours in any period of 4 hours, 8am to 6pm on Mondays to Saturdays, the following are included:-

Ditchling

- 1. High Street
- (a) East side
 - (i) from a point 1 metre north of the southern boundary of the Sandrock Inn, in a northwards direction, for a distance of 12.5 metres.
- (b) West side
 - (i) from a point 24 metres south from the prolongation of the northern building line of number 45 High Street, in a southwards direction, for a distance of 15 metres.

Ringmer

- 1. Springett Avenue
- (a) West side

- (i) from its western boundary of property 84, in a south then south-westwards direction, for a distance of 48.1 metres.
- (ii) from a point 35.7 metres north-east of its boundary with property number 45/56, in a north-eastward then northward direction, for a distance of 37.1 metres.
- (h) Schedule 3, Part G, Limited Time Prohibition of Waiting, 2 hours in any period of 4 hours, 9am to 4pm on Mondays to Fridays, 1st September to 31st May is added as follows:-

Falmer

1. East Street

(a) West side

(i) from a point opposite the southern boundary of St.Lawrence's Church, northwards for a distance of 86.5 metres.

2. Mill Street

(a) South side

- (i) between a point 15 metres east of the eastern wall of property number 81 Mill Street and a point 15 metres west of the western kerbline of Ridge Road.
- (ii) from a 34 metres west of the eastern wall of property number 81 Mill Street westwards, for a distance of 32.5 metres.

3. Park Street, south of Falmer Hill

(a) West side

(i) from a point 28 metres south of the southern wall of property number 61 Park Street southwards, for a distance of 80 metres.

4. South Street

(a) South side

- (i) from a point 15 metres east of the eastern kerbline of Park Street eastwards, for a distance of 59 metres.
- (i) Schedule 3, Part H, Limited Time Prohibition of Waiting, 4 hours in any period of 8 hours, 9am to 4pm on Mondays to Fridays, 1st September to 31st May, is added as follows:-

Falmer

1. Middle Street

(a) North side

- (i) between the eastern boundary of property number 47 and a point 15 metres west of the western kerbline of Ridge Road.
- (ii) between the western boundary of property number 43 and a point 10 metres east of the junction with the north-eastern kerbline of

Park Street.

(b) South side

- (i) between a point opposite the western boundary if property number 43 and a point 20 metres east of the junction with the southwestern kerbline of Park Street.
- (ii) between a point opposite the eastern boundary of property number 47 and a point 15 metres west of the western kerbline of Ridge Road.

2. Park Street, north of Falmer Hill

(a) West side

- (i) from a point 20 metres northwest of a point opposite the northern kerbline of Middle Street north-westwards, for a distance of 24.5 metres.
- (j) Schedule 3, Part I, Limited Time Prohibition of Waiting, 4 hours in any period of 6 hours, 9am to 5pm on Mondays to Fridays, is added as follows:-

Barcombe

1 High Street

(a) West side

- (i) from a point 108.5 metres north of a point 4 metres south of the southern boundary of the entrance to Hillside nurseries northwards, for a distance of 20.5 metres.
- (ii) from the southern building line of Barcombe Village Hall northwards, for a distance of 18 metres.
- (k) In Schedule 6, Disabled Persons' Parking Places, the following are included:-

Barcombe

1 High Street

(a) West side

(i) from a point 6 metres north of the northern building line of a property known as End Cottage northwards, for a distance of 6.5 metres.
