EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The East Sussex (A259 Bus Lane) Order 2014

East Sussex County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), as amended, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act and Traffic Management Act 2004, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex (A259 Bus Lane) Order 2014" and shall come into operation on 4 November 2014.
- The East Sussex (A259 Marine Parade Drive)(Bus Lane & Prohibition of Entry) Order 2007 is amended, as follows:
 - (a) in Article 1 after the paragraph commencing "bus stop" insert the following:
 - "bicycle" has the meaning of a vehicle with two wheels in tandem, usually propelled by pedals connected to the rear wheel by a chain, and having handlebars for steering and a saddle like seat.
 - (b) in Article 1 after the paragraph commencing "licensed taxi" insert the following:
 - "powered two wheelers" has the meaning of a mechanically propelled vehicle with two wheels without a trailer or sidecar.
 - (c) in Article 3 (1) after (e) insert (f) a bicycle and (g) powered two wheeler.
 - (d) in the heading of the FIRST SCHEDULE after BUS LANE (BUSES, TAXIS AND PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLES ONLY insert BICYCLES AND POWERED TWO WHEELERS.

(e) in the heading of the SECOND SCHEDULE after PROHIBITION OF ENTRY (EXCEPT FOR BUSES, TAXIS AND PRIVATE HIRE VEHICLES ONLY) insert BICYCLES AND POWERED TWO WHEELERS.
