## **The East Sussex County Council (Lewes District) (Off-Street Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2013**

East Sussex County Council, in collaboration with Lewes District Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 32, 35, 39(6) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), as amended by the Parking Act 1989 and the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1991, Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

### Part I – General

#### Citation

1. This Order may be cited as "The East Sussex County Council (Lewes District) (Off-Street Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2013" and shall come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2013

#### Revocation

2. The following Order is hereby revoked in its entirety:  
The East Sussex (Lewes District) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2004.

#### Interpretation

3. In this Order;

"authorised agent" means the parking services contractor appointed by and acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of supervision and enforcement of the provisions of the Order;

"articulated vehicle" means a motor vehicle with a trailer that attaches so it partially overlays the vehicle;

"car share club membership card" means a document that is displayed in a vehicle to identify that the vehicle is used by a member of East Sussex County Council staff who are registered for car sharing with TravelChoice;

"Civil Enforcement Officer or CEO" means a person authorised by or on behalf of East Sussex County Council under section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 to supervise and enforce the traffic contraventions for which East Sussex County Council is the enforcement authority;

"coach" means a chartered private hire motor vehicle adapted to carry more than eight passengers in addition to the driver;

"coach bay" means any area appointed by the Council as a parking place for a coach;

"Council" means the East Sussex County Council;

"days of charging" means the days when a parking charge applies;

“disabled persons badge or blue badge” means a badge issued by a local authority, in accordance with and in the form prescribed in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000, for display in a motor vehicle driven by or transporting a disabled badge holder.

“disabled persons badge holder or blue badge holder” means an individual or institution that was issued a disabled badge in accordance with The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

“disabled persons bay or blue badge bay” means any area appointed by the Council as a parking place for use by blue badge holders, which is marked and signed as such;

“driver” in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means that person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

“electric vehicle” means a vehicle primarily powered by an electric motor;

“heavy goods vehicle” means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for the transport of goods or burden of any description which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes;

“invalid carriage” means a mechanically propelled vehicle weighing less than 254 kilograms unladen and which is specifically designed and constructed (not adapted) for the sole use of a person with mobility difficulties;

“loading bay” means any area appointed by the Council as a parking place for use by vehicles loading or unloading goods, which is marked and signed as such;

“motor vehicle or vehicle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle intended or adapted for use on roads;

“motorcycle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) weighing less than 410 kilograms unladen, with 2 wheels and without a sidecar;

“motorcycle bay” means any area appointed by the Council as a parking place for use by motorcycles;

“operating weight” in relation to a heavy goods vehicle, means the maximum laden weight of a motor vehicle not drawing a trailer or the maximum combined laden weight of a motor vehicle (including articulated vehicles) and any trailer or trailers attached to it;

“owner” in relation to a vehicle means the person registered with the DVLA as the keeper;

“parking bay” means any area appointed by the Council as a parking place for use by motor vehicles which is identified by markings;

“parking charge” means the amount payable, if applicable, as detailed in Schedule 2, for a motor vehicle being left in any parking place listed in Schedule 1;

"parking period" means the time a vehicle is permitted to park in any of the parking places listed in Schedule 1, providing, if applicable, the relevant parking charge has been paid;

"parking place" means any area of land appointed by the Council as an area for the leaving (parking) of motor vehicles;

"penalty charge" means the charge set under the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1991, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, Local Government and the Regions, which is to be paid to the Council following the issue of a penalty charge notice;

"penalty charge notice or PCN" means a notice issued or served by a CEO in accordance to the provisions of section 66 of the Road Traffic Act 1991;

"permit" means a document that is displayed in a vehicle which identifies it as having permission to use a parking place signed with the matching code and is issued in accordance with Article 15 of this Order;

"permit holder" means an individual who has been issued a permit in accordance with Article 15 of this Order;

"persistent evader" means a vehicle with a minimum of 5 PCNs issued which have an outstanding balance;

"scratch card permit" means a document that requires the date or time, or both are scratched off prior to it being displayed in a vehicle, which identifies it as having permission to use a parking place with the matching code and is issued in accordance with Article 15 of this Order;

"specific user bay" means any area appointed by the Council as a parking place for use by a particular class of vehicle or driver;

"tariff sign" means the sign in a car park which details the terms of use and where applicable, the charges for using the parking place.

"ticket" means a voucher issued by a pay and display machine which records the parking charge paid and the time and date the parking period expires;

"time clock" means a piece of equipment that can show the time a parking period has begun, to within 15 minutes, and is to be displayed with a valid disabled badge (blue badge);

"times of charging" means the hours when a parking charge applies;

"trailer" means a non mechanically propelled vehicle which is towed by a motor vehicle;

"waiver" means a document that is displayed in a vehicle which identifies it as having permission to use a parking place which would otherwise be restricted or prohibited.

## Part II – Use of Parking Places

Vehicles provided for

4. Each area of land specified in Schedule 1 of this Order may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a parking place for the vehicle type, on the days and times, and on payment of any relevant charges or display of a valid disabled badge or permit, or both, as specified in the Schedule unless a valid waiver is displayed.
5. Motor vehicles using the parking places listed in Schedule 1 of this Order must not exceed 2.1 metres in height, 5.5 metres in length or 5 tonnes in weight.
6. Vehicles towing a trailer or caravan, or a disconnected trailer or caravan, are not permitted to use the parking places listed in Schedule 1 of this Order.

#### Parking periods and restriction on re-entry

7. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum length of stay for that parking place as specified in Schedule 1.
8. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to return to a parking place before the minimum length of time between stays has elapsed for that parking place as specified in Schedule 1.

#### Payment of charge

9. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall pay the parking charge relevant to that parking place as specified in Schedule 1 and detailed in Schedule 2 of this Order, except on Bank Holidays and Public Holidays when the parking charge does not apply.
10. The parking charge shall be paid:
  - (a) where facilities allow, by the insertion of coins into a pay and display ticket machine which is approved in accordance with Section 35(3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended); or
  - (b) where facilities allow, by a pre-paid card at a pay and display ticket machine which is approved in accordance with Section 35(3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended); or
  - (c) where facilities allow, by a mobile telephone payment.
11. When payment of a parking charge is made using a pay and display ticket machine, a ticket will be issued by the machine identifying the amount paid and the expiry time of the parking period. This ticket is non transferable between parking places or vehicles and must be displayed in the vehicle as set out in Article 17 of this Order.
12. When payment is made by mobile telephone, the parking place will be identified by the Location Identification Number (LIN) displayed on the information signs and the parking period paid for will only be valid for that specific parking place

and vehicle. The LIN, parking charge paid and parking period will be available for CEOs to view on their hand held devices when the Vehicle Registration Mark (VRM) is entered.

13. If, when a vehicle is parked in one of the parking places listed in Schedule 1 of this Order, payment of the parking charge is not possible using the drivers preferred method, it should be paid using any alternative method available. Where there is a problem with a pay and display ticket machine, the driver should check if there is another machine in that parking place that could be used.
14. Only if all of the facilities for paying the parking charge at a parking place are not working or have been covered by an authorised agent, will the driver of that vehicle be exempt from paying the parking charge.

#### Issuing of permits

15. Permits may be issued to an individual or organisation by the Council or Lewes District Council according to their own permit policies.
16. A permit will be issued with a particular code on it which identifies where the permit can be used. If the permit is valid in a parking place listed in Schedule 1 of this Order, the code will be on the tariff sign.

#### Display of tickets, permits, waivers and blue badges

17. A valid ticket shall be continuously displayed in a vehicle so that the amount paid, expiry date and expiry time of the parking period is clearly visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle, for its entire length of stay in that parking place.
18. A valid permit shall be continuously displayed in a vehicle so that the VRM, permit code and expiry date, or in the case of a scratch card permit the VRM, permit code and date when parking is allowed, including the time where applicable, is clearly visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle, for its entire length of stay in that parking place.
19. A valid waiver shall be continuously displayed in a vehicle so that the location, dates and times of the waiver are clearly visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle, for its entire length of stay in that parking place.
20. A valid blue badge shall be continuously displayed in a vehicle so that the serial number, issuing authority and expiry date, and where applicable, the time clock set at the time of arrival, are clearly visible from the front or nearside of the vehicle, for its entire length of stay in that parking place.

#### Contraventions in a parking place and penalty charges

21. A penalty charge may be payable if a vehicle is left in a parking place without complying with the provisions of the Order. A contravention shall be deemed to have occurred if:

- (a) a vehicle is parked after expiry of the parking period for which the parking charge (where applicable) was paid; or
- (b) a vehicle is parked without displaying a valid ticket in accordance with Article 17 of this Order or a valid permit in accordance with Article 18 of this Order, or where necessary both, or a valid waiver in accordance with Article 19, or a valid blue badge in accordance with Article 20, as required for that parking place, detailed in Schedule 1 of this Order; or
- (c) where facilities allow payment by a mobile telephone, confirmation of a valid parking period or parking charge paid for that parking place does not appear on the CEO's hand held device when the VRM is entered; or
- (d) a vehicle is parked in a parking bay or part of a parking place designated for a specific user and it is not of that class of vehicle or driver; or
- (e) where there are marked bays in a parking place, a vehicle is not parked fully within a marked bay; or
- (f) a vehicle is parked on a yellow line or area of hatching marked to indicate where parking is prohibited; or
- (g) a vehicle is parked obstructing the entrance or exit of the parking place or causing an obstruction to other vehicles using the parking place; or
- (h) a vehicle exceeds the permitted length, height or weight as specified in Article 5 of this Order; or
- (i) a vehicle exceeds the maximum length of stay for that parking place as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order; or
- (j) a vehicle returns to the same parking place before the minimum length of time between stays has elapsed as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order; or
- (k) a vehicle is using the parking place for any purpose other than parking, as listed in Article 24.

22. When a CEO identifies a contravention as having occurred they may issue a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) which they will either attach to the vehicle in a noticeable position or hand to the driver of the vehicle.

23. The driver of a vehicle which has been issued a PCN can pay the penalty charge to the Council by:

- (1)(a) telephone, using a secure line which is available 24 hours, 7 days a week; or
  - (b) in person at the Parking Shop by cash, cheque or postal order; or
  - (c) online, using a secure link from the Councils website; or
  - (d) sending credit or debit card details using the tear off slip at the bottom of a PCN, cheque or postal orders, by post to:  
East Sussex County Council, The Parking Shop, PO Box 80, Lewes, BN7 2WU.
- (2) The amount of penalty charge referred to in Article 23(1) above shall be as set out in Schedule 3 depending upon the date on which payment is received for the PCN by the Council.

Activities not permitted in a parking place

24. When a vehicle is in a parking place listed in Schedule 1 of this Order it will not be used for or in connection with:

- (a) the sale of any item to persons in or near the parking place; or
- (b) the selling or offering for hire of skills or services; or
- (c) any other business or professional purposes; or
- (d) sleeping, camping, cooking or eating purposes; or
- (e) servicing, repairing or washing other than that necessary to enable the vehicle to leave the parking place;

except with prior written permission from the Council.

25. When in a parking place listed in Schedule 1 of this Order no person will:

- (a) erect or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure except with prior written permission from the Council; or
- (b) light or permit to be lit any fire; or
- (c) display or distribute any notice, leaflet, handbill, booklet, book or other item; or
- (d) use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear; or
- (e) shout or make any other noise, music or otherwise behave in a manner to cause disturbance or annoyance to other users of the parking place, occupants of neighbouring premises or passersby; or



- (g) use any part of the parking place for skating, skateboarding, cycling, playing or taking part in any game or racing.

#### Vehicles exempt from payment of any charge

- 26. A vehicle which displays a valid blue badge, and where applicable, a time clock, as set out in Article 20 of this Order, may park without charge as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

#### Clamping, moving and removal of a vehicle

- 27. When a persistent evader is identified in a parking place, a person authorised on behalf of the Council may clamp the vehicle. The owner is responsible for the payment of the clamping fees before their vehicle will be released. If the vehicle is in contravention at the time it is identified and a PCN is issued, this must also be paid before the vehicle is released.
- 28. When a contravention of this Order has occurred or a persistent evader is identified, a person authorised on behalf of the Council may move the vehicle to a different position within that parking place so that it complies with the provisions of this Order, or remove the vehicle completely from the parking place.
- 29. Any person authorised by the Council for moving or removal of vehicles in a parking place may do so by any manner they think necessary and when removing a vehicle from a parking place, will make sure the vehicle is stored securely until such time as the owner claims the vehicle. The owner is responsible for the payment of any removal and storage charges before their car will be released.

#### Closing and setting aside areas for specific use

- 30. The Council reserves the right to:

- (a) close any parking place, or part of a parking place, referred to in Schedule 1 of this Order, when it requires, for the purpose of County Council meetings or other events deemed by the Council to be valid reasons for closure. In such circumstances the Council will not be required to refund to a valid permit holder any part of the permit cost;
- (b) set aside any parking place, or part of a parking place, referred to in Schedule 1 of this Order, for any length of time necessary, for exclusive use by a particular organisation, group of people or type of vehicle. In such circumstances the Council will not be required to refund to a valid permit holder any part of the permit cost.
