THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON ENTRANCE MARKINGS) (ZIGZAGS) ORDER 2005

The Council of the Borough of Eastleigh (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

PART 1- GENERAL

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6 May 2005 and may be cited as the "Borough of Eastleigh (Prohibition of Stopping on Entrance Markings) (Zigzags) Order 2005".

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"entrance marking" means any area designated as such by the Articles of this Order and are contained in the First Schedule of this Order;

"parking attendant" shall have the same meaning as in section 63A of the Act:

"telecommunication apparatus" has the same meaning as in Section 4 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle and "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act.

- (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- (3) The conditions, provisions, prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other such matter imposed by any Order or regulation made, or having effect as if made, under the Act of 1984, or by or under any other enactment.
- (4) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

PART II- PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON ENTRANCE MARKINGS

- 3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or with the permission of a parking attendant, cause or permit any vehicle to stop or remain at rest on an entrance marking:
 - (a) at any time on the roads specified in the First Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) between the hours of 8am and 10am and between the hours of 2pm and 4pm on any day other than a Saturday or a Sunday on the roads specified in the Second Schedule to this Order.
- 4. Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to stop or wait on an entrance marking:
 - (a) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his or her control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
 - (b) the vehicle is a vehicle used for Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or a vehicle in the service of the Police Force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely
 - i. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road or length of road;
 - ii. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said sides of roads or lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus;
- 5. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles other than stage carriages or express carriages in a bus stop area or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, that provision of that Order shall prevail.

Blackbird Road





Shakespeare Infant School Shakespeare Road








Shakespeare Junior School St Catherines Road









Fryern Infant & Junior Schools Oakmount Road



Merdon Avenue & Brownhill Road



Scantabout Primary School Peverells Wood Avenue





Sherbourne House School Lakewood Road











Wildern Secondary School Wildern Lane






