THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (EASTLEIGH TOWN CENTRE) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO. 4) ORDER 2006

The Council of the Borough of Eastleigh (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 51 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 6 March 2006 and may be cited as the "Borough of Eastleigh (Eastleigh Town Centre) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment No. 4) Order 2006".

Revocations and amendments

Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting

- 2. The Borough of Eastleigh (Eastleigh Town Centre) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2004 is hereby amended as follows:
 - (i) The following shall be added to Article 2(1)

"charged parking place" means a parking place referred to in the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules;

"chargeable hours" means between the hours and on the days specified in the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules;

"parking charge" for a vehicle left in a charged parking place shall be determined by reference to the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules;

"parking period" for a vehicle left in a charged parking place shall be determined by reference to the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules;

"parking ticket" means a ticket issued by a ticket machine relating to a parking place;

"relevant position" in relation to a parking ticket means the ticket is exhibited on the dashboard or facia or windscreen of the vehicle, so that the front of the ticket is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

"restricted zone" is all the lengths of road specified in the Fifteenth Schedule

"ticket machine" means apparatus designed to indicate the time and to issue parking tickets indicating the payment of a charge and the period in respect of which it has been paid;

- (ii) Article 3(a) shall have "and the Fifteenth Schedule Part A" added before the words "to this Order".
- (iii) Article 4 shall be revoked and replaced with:

Charged Parking Places

4. (1) Each of the parts of road specified in the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules is to be used subject to the following provisions of this Order and are hereby designed as charged parking places on such days, during such hours and for such parking charges as are specified in those Schedules in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedules.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any parking place.

- 4A. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 24 of this Order no person shall, except on direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the chargeable hours in a charged parking place described in the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules unless it is a vehicle of appropriate class for that parking place and unless the parking charge has been paid in accordance with the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules.
- 4B. Provided always that the payment of the parking charge shall be indicated by the vehicle displaying in the relevant position at all times whilst so parked a parking ticket issued by the ticket machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle has been left.
- (iv) Article 5 shall be amended to read:
- 5A. Each of the parts of road specified in the Sixth, Eleventh and the Fifteenth (Part D) Schedules to this Order is to be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as street parking for the parking during the permitted hours by such classes of vehicles specified in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedules.

- 5B. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 24 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in the Fourth Schedule to this Order-
 - (a) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.
- (v) Article 6 shall be amended to read:
- 6. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 24 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order-
 - (a) for a longer period than 1 hour; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 2 hours have elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.
- (vi) After Article 7 there shall be inserted
 - 7A. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 24 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a parking attendant cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Part B of the Fifteenth Schedule to this Order-
 - (a) for a longer period than 1 hour; or

(b) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.

- (vii) Article 9 shall have "and 7A" added before the words "of this Order".
- (viii) Article 11 shall have "and the Fifteenth Schedule Part C" added before the words "to this Order".
- (ix) Article 12 shall have "and the Fifteenth Schedule Part C" added before the words "to this Order".

- (x) Article 14 shall have "and the Fifteenth Schedule Part D" added before the words "to this Order".
- (xi) After Article 15 there shall be inserted:
 - 15A. Save as provided in Article 24 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a parking attendant cause or permit any motorcycle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Part D of the Fifteenth Schedule to this Order-
 - (a) for a longer period than 1 hour; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the motorcycle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.

- (xii) Article 16 shall have "and the Fifteenth Schedule Part E" added before the words "to this Order".
- (xiii) After Article 19 there shall be added:

Ticket Machines

- 19A.There shall be a ticket machine on or in the vicinity of each of the parking places referred to in the Fourth, Fifth and Fifteenth (Part B) Schedules to this Order.
- 19B. No parking charge shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a charged parking place during the chargeable hours if:
 - (a) At the time the vehicle was left in that charged parking place there was on that ticket machine relating to that charged parking place a notice placed by a parking attendant or any person duly authorised by the Council indicating that the ticket machine relating to that charged parking place was out of order; and
 - (b) There is no other ticket machine available to be used for that charged parking place; and
 - (c) The vehicle is removed within one hour of the ticket machine defect being rectified.

(xiv) FIRST SCHEDULE - No Waiting At Any Time

Item 75 shall be revoked and replaced with the following:
