THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (BISHOPSTOKE, FAIR OAK AND HORTON HEATH) (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.3 ORDER 2009

The Council of the Borough of Eastleigh (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 27 August 2009 and may be cited as the "Borough of Eastleigh (Bishopstoke, Fair Oak and Horton Heath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (Amendment No.3) Order 2009".

Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting

- In this Order the Principal Order means The Borough of Eastleigh (Bishopstoke, Fair Oak and Horton Heath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Disabled Persons Parking Places) Order 2004
- 3. The Principal Order is hereby amended as follows:
 - (a) In Article 20 after paragraph (b) there shall be inserted:
 - (c) Between the hours of 8.30am and 9.30am and 3.00pm and 4.00pm on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads, or in any lengths of roads specified in the Seventh Schedule to this Order.
 - (b) In the First Schedule (No Waiting at Any Time) before item number 1 relating to Blackberry Drive there shall be inserted:
- A. Abbotsbury Road Inner side of in the centre of the turning circle near the entrance to Stoke Park Infant School.

(c) In the First Schedule (No Waiting at Any Time) item number 24 relating to Hamilton Road shall be revoked and replaced with:

24. Hamilton Road North From its junction with Spring Lane eastwards

for a distance of 22 metres.

24A. Hamilton Road South From its junction with Spring Lane eastwards

for a distance of 39 metres.

(d) In the Fifth Schedule (Areas on the Highway Designated as Disabled Persons Parking Places) item number 2 relating to East Drive shall be revoked and replaced with:
