THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (HEDGE END, WEST END AND BOTLEY)
CONSOLIDATION ORDER 2015

The Council of the Borough of Eastleigh (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45, 46 and 51 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

PART I- GENERAL

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 7 September 2015 and may be cited as the "Borough of Eastleigh (Hedge End, West End and Botley) Consolidation Order 2015".

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:-

"car park permit" means a ticket or card issued by the Council in respect of a particular vehicle which entitles the holder to leave that vehicle in a parking place at any time in accordance with the provisions of this Order up to and including the date of expiry as shown on the permit;

"charged parking place" means a parking place referred to in Schedule 2;

"chargeable hours" means between the hours and on the days specified in Schedule 2;

"civil enforcement officer" shall have the same meaning as in section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"disabled parking disc" means a device which:-

- (a) is coloured blue;
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid;
and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun.

"disabled person's badge" means a badge which was-

- (a) issued, or has effect as if issued, to a disabled person or an institution under the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000 or under regulations having effect in Scotland or Wales under section 21 of the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970; and
- (b) has not ceased to be in force;

as defined in The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

“disabled persons parking place” means each of the various areas of land specified in the Schedule 6 to this Order;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled persons badge, as defined under Section 142 of the Act;

“driver”, in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place or street or part of a street specified in this Order, means the person in charge of the vehicle at the same time it was left in the parking place or street or part of a street aforesaid;

“entrance marking” means any area designated as such by Article 40 of this Order and are contained in Schedule 7 of this Order;

“goods” includes all chattels personal, other than things in action and money, including postal packets of any description and “delivery and collection”, in relation to any goods, includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

“goods vehicle” means a vehicle not exceeding 3.5 tonnes max gross weight and which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description, and is not a drawing trailer;

“invalid carriage” means a mechanically propelled vehicle of which the weight unladen does not exceed 254 kilograms and which is specially designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical default or disability and is used solely by such person as defined in Section 136 of the Act;

“loading bay” means an area on the highway designated and described as a loading bay by Article 30 and is contained in Schedule 5 of this Order;

“motor cycle” means a mechanically propelled vehicle (not being an invalid carriage) with fewer than 4 wheels, of which the weight unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms as defined in Section 136 of the Act;

“owner”, in relation to a vehicle, means the person named in the vehicle registration document or the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;

“parking charge” for a vehicle left in a charged parking place shall be determined by reference to Schedule 2;

“parking place” means an area on the highway designated and described as a parking place by any of the various Articles or Schedules of this Order;

“parking period” for a vehicle left in a charged parking place shall be determined by reference to Schedule 2;

“parking space” means a space in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle;

“parking ticket” means a ticket issued by a ticket machine relating to a parking place;

“passenger vehicle” means a vehicle (other than a motorcycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver, and not drawing a trailer;

“permitted hours” means between the times specified in the various Articles and Schedules to this Order.

“postal packet” means a letter, parcel, packet or other article transmissible by post as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000

“relevant position” in relation to a parking ticket means the ticket is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia or windscreen of the vehicle, so that the front of the ticket is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle;

“telecommunication apparatus” has the same meaning as in Section 4 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 as it was originally in force;

“ticket machine” means apparatus designed to indicate the time and to issue parking tickets indicating the payment of a charge and the period in respect of which it has been paid;

“vehicle” means a motor vehicle and “motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act;

“verge” means any unmetalled area between the edge of the carriageway and the highway boundary.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if it is displayed in accordance with The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000.

(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment unless otherwise specified herein

(4) The conditions, provisions, prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other such matter imposed by any Order or regulation made, or having effect as if made, under the Act of 1984, or by or under any other enactment.

(5) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

PART II- AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

3. (1) Each of the parts of a road specified in this Order but excluding such parts as are designated as no waiting and/or no loading is to be used subject to the following provisions of this Order as street parking for the parking during the permitted hours by such classes of vehicles specified in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedules.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any parking place.

4. Where in the Schedules to this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is:

- (a) of the specified class; and
- (b) parked wholly within the limits of the parking place.

5. A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place:

- (a) So as to unreasonably prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance;
- (b) When the Council has closed that parking place.

6. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or depart from the parking place.

Exemptions for disabled persons

7. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 3 of this Order a vehicle which bears on the windscreen thereof or, if the vehicle has no windscreen, in a conspicuous position thereon, a badge issued by any local authority in accordance with the provisions of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemption for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 or a badge

having effect under those regulations as if it were a disabled persons badge may be left during the permitted hours in a parking place.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of this Article, a vehicle to which this Article applies shall stand in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of Article 9 of this Order and wholly within the limits of that place.

Placing of Traffic Signs

8. The Council shall:

- (a) cause the limits of each parking place to be indicated on the carriageway by placing and maintaining thereon traffic signs of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Act;
- (b) place and maintain on or in the vicinity of each parking place traffic signs of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Act indicating that such parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 3 to this Order; and
- (c) carry out such other works as are reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

Manner of Standing in Parking Places

9. Every vehicle left in a parking place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall so stand, in the case of any parking place:-

- (a) That except where the limits of the parking place are marked out otherwise the left or nearside of the vehicle is adjacent to the left-hand edge of the carriageway and that the distance between the edge of the carriageway and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres;
- (b) that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place.

Alteration of Position of Vehicles in Parking Places

10. Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provisions of the last preceding Article or of the provisions of Article 7(2) of this Order a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with these provisions.

Removal of Vehicles from Parking Places

11. Where a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Article 15(1) of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place, he or she may remove or cause to be removed the

vehicle from the parking place, and where it is so removed shall provide for safe custody of the vehicle.

Movement of Vehicles in Parking Places in Emergencies

12. A Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer may remove or cause to be moved in cases of emergency, to any place he or she thinks fit, any vehicle left in a parking place.

Power to Suspend the Use of Parking Places

13. (1) Any person duly authorised by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or of any part thereof whenever he or she considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-

- (a) for the purpose of facilitating movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
- (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or adjacent highway or part of the highway or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus or traffic sign;
- (c) for the purpose of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository provided that such removal is for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place;
- (d) for the purpose that any street may be thronged or obstructed by reason of some special attraction;
- (e) for the purpose of parking at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions provided that such parking is for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place;

(2) A Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer may suspend for not longer than 24 hours the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he or she considers that such suspension is reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting safety.

(3) Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) or (2) of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or a part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

(4) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any parking place or part of a parking place during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part of a parking place a traffic sign placed in

pursuance of paragraph (3) of this Article provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or any vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Article 15(1)(b), (d) or (e) of this Order to be left in the parking place or part of a parking place during any such period, or to cause or to permit any other vehicle to be so left if that vehicle is left with the permission:-

- (a) of the person suspending the use of the parking place or a part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) of this Article,
- (b) of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer.

Restriction of Use of Vehicles at Parking Places

14. No person shall use any vehicle, whilst it is in a parking place during the permitted hours, in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for sale of a skill or handicraft or service in any other capacity.

Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle if the vehicle is a passenger vehicle, goods vehicle of any weight or motorcycle or invalid carriage and the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into the premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is affected.

Restriction of Waiting of Vehicles in Parking Places

15. (1) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this Order with respect to vehicles left in parking places in accordance with those provisions, any vehicle may wait during the permitted hours anywhere on the carriageway in a parking place, other than a parking place, or part of a parking place the use of which has been suspended, if:-

- (a) the vehicle is waiting only so long as is necessary to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
- (b) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his or her control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
- (c) the vehicle is a vehicle used for Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of the local authority or water authority or a vehicle in the service of the Police Force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers of duties;
- (d) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (e) the vehicle is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle, or, having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting;

- (f) the vehicle is in use in connection with the servicing of telephone kiosks;
- (g) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is waiting only for so long as may be reasonably necessary to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in Article 13(1) of this Order;
- (h) the vehicle, not being a passenger vehicle, is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or household to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;
- (i) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as is necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the posting or removing of advertising materials in the form of posters, or cleaning windows or chimneys in premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting; or
- (j) in any other case the vehicle is waiting for as long as is necessary for the purpose of delivery or collection of goods or mechanise, including, as far as a bank is concerned, cash or other valuables or valuable securities, or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting.

(2) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this Article shall be taken as authorising anything which would be a contravention of any regulations made or having effect as if made under Section 35 of the Act.

Manner of Waiting in Parking Places

16. A person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in a parking place by virtue of the provisions of sub-paragraph (e), (f), (g), (h) or (i) in paragraph (1) of the last preceding Article shall, except where the parking place is other than at right angles to the edge of the carriageway, take all such steps as are necessary to ensure that the longitudinal axis of the vehicle is parallel to the edge of the carriageway nearest to the vehicle and the distance between the said edge and the nearest wheel of the vehicle is not more than 300 millimetres and in each and every case so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of the parking place.

Charged Parking Places

17.(1) Each of the parts of road specified in Schedule 2 is to be used subject to the provisions of this Order and are hereby designated as charged parking places on such days, during such hours and for such parking charges as are specified in that Schedule in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedule.

(2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council to close any parking place.

18. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 31 of this Order no person shall, except on direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait during the

chargeable hours in a charged parking place described in Schedule 2 unless it is a vehicle of appropriate class for that parking place and unless the parking charge has been paid in accordance with Schedule 2.

19. Provided always that the payment of the parking charge shall be indicated by the vehicle displaying in the relevant position at all times whilst so parked a parking ticket issued by the ticket machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle has been left, unless the vehicle has the benefit of an exemption as specified in Article 20.
20. The following vehicles shall be exempt from the display of any parking ticket:
 1. A disabled persons vehicle which displays in a relevant position a disabled persons badge;
 2. A motorcycle parked in a motorcycle bay;
 3. A vehicle displaying at all times in a conspicuous position to the vehicle a valid car park permit issued by the Local Authority in respect of that vehicle and for the particular zone or car park where the vehicle is parked.

Ticket Machines

21. There shall be a ticket machine on or in the vicinity of each of the parking places referred to in Schedule 2 to this Order.
22. No parking charge shall be payable in respect of any vehicle waiting in a charged parking place during the chargeable hours if:
 - (a) At the time the vehicle was left in that charged parking place there was on that ticket machine relating to that charged parking place a notice placed by a Civil Enforcement Officer or any person duly authorised by the Council indicating that the ticket machine relating to that charged parking place was out of order; and
 - (b) There is no other ticket machine available to be used for that charged parking place; and
 - (c) So long as the vehicle is removed within the maximum duration permitted for parking in that parking place.

PART III- PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, INCLUDING A BAN ON LOADING AND UNLOADING

23. Save as provided in Articles 31 and 32 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait:
 - (a) at any time in the roads, on the sides of roads, or in any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;

- (b) between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads, or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.1 to this Order;
 - (c) between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads, or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.2 to this Order;
 - (d) between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00 pm on any day between 1 May and 30 September inclusive in the roads, on the sides of roads, or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.3 to this Order;
 - (e) between the hours of 2.00pm and 3.00pm on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads, or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.4 to this Order;
 - (f) between the hours of 8.00am and 9.00am and 2.30pm and 3.30pm on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday between 1 September and 31 July in the roads, on the sides of roads, or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.5 to this Order.
 - (g) between the hours of 8.00am and 9.00am and 2.30pm and 4.00pm on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.6 to this Order;
 - (h) between the hours of 8.00am and 9.00am and 3.00pm and 4.00pm on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.7 to this Order;
 - (i) between the hours of 10.00am and 11.00am and 2.00pm and 3.00pm on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.8 to this Order;
 - (j) between the hours of 10.00am and 11.00am on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday in the roads, on the sides of roads or in any lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1.9 to this Order;
24. Save as provided in Articles 31 and 33 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this Order-
- (a) for a longer period than 30 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 30 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.
25. Save as provided in Articles 31 and 33 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3.1 to this Order-

- (a) for a longer period than 2 hours; or
- (b) if a period of less than 3 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.

26. Save as provided in Articles 31 and 33 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3.2 to this Order-

- (a) for a longer period than 2 hours; or
- (b) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.

27. Save as provided in Articles 31 and 33 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3.5 to this Order-

- (a) for a longer period than 2 hours; or
- (b) if a period of less than 4 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.

28. Save as provided in Articles 31 and 33 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am and 6.00pm on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3.3 to this Order-

- (a) for a longer period than 20 minutes; or
- (b) if a period of less than 40 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.

29. Save as provided in Articles 31 and 33 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3.4 to this Order-

- (a) for a longer period than 20 minutes; or

(b) if a period of less than 40 minutes has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) of the vehicle on those sides of roads or in those lengths of roads.

30. (a) Each of the parts of roads specified in Schedule 5 to this Order is hereby designated as and is authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a loading bay.

(b) Save as provided in Article 33 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the parking places specified in Schedule 5 except a goods vehicle for the purposes of loading and unloading during the permitted hours, Monday to Saturday 9am to 6pm.

31. Nothing in Articles 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 30 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads referred to therein for so long as is necessary to enable-

(a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
(b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
(c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely-

- i. building, industrial or demolition operation;
- ii. the removal of any obstruction by traffic;
- iii. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road or length of road;
- iv. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said sides of roads or lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus;

(d) the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

(e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000; or

(f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigades, Ambulance or Police purposes specifically whilst engaged in emergency work.

32. Nothing in Article 23 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and a disabled parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) issued by any local authority to wait on the sides of roads referred to in that Article for a period not exceeding three hours

not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road.

33. Nothing in Articles 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 29 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge to wait on the sides of roads referred to in that Article.
34. No person shall cause goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle:
 - (a) at any time on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 4 to this Order;
 - (b) between the hours of 7.00am-10.00am and 4.00pm- 7.00pm on the sides of roads or in the lengths of roads referred to in Schedule 4.1 to this Order.

PART IV- DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES

35. Each of the parts of roads specified in Schedule 6 to this Order are hereby designated as, and is authorised to be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, as a street disabled persons parking place for disabled persons vehicles in such positions as are specified in relation to that part of the road in the said Schedule.
36. Nothing in Article 35 of this Order shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of the streets, by Order on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any disabled persons parking place.
37. The disabled persons parking places designated by this Order and set out in Schedule 6 shall be used in accordance with the Articles set out in this Order and the articles shall apply to them as if where the words “parking place” and “Schedule” are used those phrases were substituted by “disabled persons parking place” and “Schedule 6” respectively.
38. At all times which a vehicle is left in a disabled persons parking place during the permitted hours there shall be displayed in the relevant position a valid disabled persons badge.
39. Where a disabled persons badge has been displayed on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 2 of this Order, no person, not being the driver of the vehicle, shall remove the badge from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.

PART V- PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON ENTRANCE MARKINGS

40. Save as provided in Article 41 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any vehicle

to stop or remain at rest on an entrance marking at any time on the roads specified in Schedule 7 to this Order;

41. Nothing in Article 40 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit a vehicle to stop or wait on an entrance marking if:
- (a) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his or her control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
 - (b) the vehicle is a vehicle used for Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes or a vehicle in the service of the Police Force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) the vehicle is waiting only for so long as may be necessary to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely-
 - i. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road or length of road;
 - ii. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said sides of roads or lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus;

PART VI- PROHIBITION OF VERGE PARKING

42. Save as provided in Article 43 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Civil Enforcement Officer cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the verge of any of the roads in Schedule 8 to this Order.
43. Nothing in Article 42 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the verge of roads referred to therein for so long as is necessary to enable-
- (a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely-
 - i. the removal of any obstruction by traffic;
 - ii. the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road or length of road;
 - iii. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said sides of roads or lengths of roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus;

- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000; or
- (f) the vehicle to be used for Fire Brigades, Ambulance or Police purposes.

PART VII- REVOCATION OF EXISTING TRAFFIC REGULATION PROVISIONS

44. The Orders specified in Column One of Schedule 9 to this Order are hereby revoked insofar as specified in Column Two of Schedule 9.
45. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with a provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles other than stage carriages or express carriages in a bus stop area or grants an exemption from such restriction or prohibition, that provision of that Order shall prevail.
