THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (THE DISTRICT OF SHEPWAY) (FOLKESTONE WEST CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE) (NO 2) ORDER 2012

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL acting as the local traffic authority and in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 5, 32, 45, 46 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers and after consultation with the Chief of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to said Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT:

 This Order may be cited as "The Kent County Council (The District of Shepway) (Folkestone West Controlled Parking Zone) Consolidation Order 2012 and shall come into effect on the 17th September 2012

REVOCATIONS:

2. This Order shall revoke all restrictions on the lengths of the roads mentioned herein from the "The Kent County Council (The District of Shepway) (Folkestone West Controlled Parking Zone) Order 2012" and any subsequent amendments and consolidate them in this Order

INTERPRETATION AND DEFINITIONS:

3. In this Order:-

"the Act of 1984" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"the Council" means the Kent County Council as traffic authority and, where appropriate, Shepway District Council acting on behalf of the traffic authority.

"ambulance" means any vehicle that is:

- (a) constructed or adapted for no purpose other than the carriage of sick, injured or disabled people to and from welfare centres or places where medical or dental treatment is given.
- (b) readily identifiable as a vehicle used for the carriage of such people by being marked "Ambulance" on both sides.

As defined in Schedule 2 of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act (VERA) 1994

"civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 Traffic Management Act 2004 a civil enforcement officer appointed under section 63A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 is a civil enforcement officer in relation to parking contraventions.

"delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods include checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"disabled person" and "disabled person's badge" (DPB) have the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons' (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

"disabled person's vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a disabled person's badge and which is a vehicle which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 to be included in an Order under the Act of 1984, has been or is to be driven by a

disabled person or, as the case may be, has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"goods" has the meaning that the goods which are being loaded or unloaded must be of such burden of weight or bulk that they cannot reasonably be conveyed otherwise than by means of a vehicle. The goods must be of a type that cannot easily be carried by one person in one trip.

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description or a trailer so constructed or adapted;

"invalid carriage" means a mechanically propelled vehicle of which the weight unladen does not exceed 254 kilograms and which is specially designed and constructed, and not merely adapted, for the use of a person suffering from some physical default or disability and is used solely by such a person;

"junction" means the junction of the marked, or if not so marked, the imaginary centre lines of the roads referred to and, where appropriate, measurements shall be taken from the point of intersection of the respective centre lines as projected;

"licensed taxi" has the same meaning as in section 13 (3) (a) of the Transport Act 1985;

"loading and unloading" has the meaning that the loading or unloading of the goods to or from a vehicle is a continuous process and that stopping for any other reason, except an emergency, would mean that the act of loading or unloading has ceased. The vehicle must be parked as close to the building where the goods are being delivered to, or collected from, as possible.

"motor car" and "motor cycle" have the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"owner", in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used;

"parking disc" means a device which-

- (a) is 125 millimetres square and coloured blue, if issued on or after 1st April 2000 or orange, if issued before that date;
- b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting has begun.

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver, and not drawing a trailer;

"Penalty Charge Notice" (PCN) means a notice of Penalty Charge issued or served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

"public service vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;



"relevant position" means:-

1 - In the case of a Disabled Person's Badge -

(a) A vehicle displays a disabled person's badge in the relevant position if:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited thereon so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from the outside the vehicle; or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that Part 1 of the badge is legible from outside the vehicle.

(b) A vehicle displays a parking disc in the relevant position if:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a dashboard or fascia panel, the disc is exhibited thereon so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle; or

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not so fitted, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the quarter-hour period during which the period of waiting began is legible from outside the vehicle.

2 - In the case of any other badge or permit -

A vehicle displays any other badge or permit in the relevant position if:-

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the item is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the item is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle.

"resident" has the meaning of any household, business or organisation at an address within a parking zone

"restricted road" means any of the roads, lengths of road or sides of road specified in the First or Second Schedules to this Order:-

PROVIDED ALWAYS that the expression "restricted road" shall not for the purposes of this Order include any designated parking place or any authorised parking place described in the various Schedules to this Order and not suspended under the provisions of Article 14;

"road" means the full width - including any footway or verge - of any length of highway or of any other road to which the public has access, and includes bridges over which a road passes;

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, section 64 of the Act of 1984;

"Transportation Manager" means such person as shall be approved by Shepway District Council to manage the Transportation Department and;

Part A - General and Definitions

"Transportation Department" means the service established by Shepway District Council to carry out parking activities under the Kent Highways partnership agreement between Kent County Council, as traffic authority, and Shepway District Council;

"vehicle" means a motor vehicle or a trailer and "motor vehicle" and "trailer" have the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"Zone B" means the lengths of road contained in Schedules 3 and 4 of this Order

(2) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires:-

- (a) any reference to a numbered Article or a numbered Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order;
- (b) any reference to a numbered or lettered paragraph or sub-paragraph is a reference to the paragraph or sub-paragraph bearing that number or letter in the Article or Schedule or (in the case of a sub-paragraph) paragraph in which the reference occurs; and
- (c) any reference to a Table, or to a numbered Table, is a reference to the Table, or to the Table bearing that number, in the Article or Schedule in which that reference occurs.

(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment;

(4) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made under or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 or by or under any other enactment;

(5) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Part B - Restrictions on the waiting of vehicles

PART B RESTRICTIONS ON THE WAITING OF VEHICLES

PROHIBITION OF WAITING

- 4. Save as in Part C of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform, a civil enforcement officer or any person authorised by the Council, cause or permit a vehicle to **wait** on any length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
- 5. Save as in Part C of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform, a civil enforcement officer or any person authorised by the Council, cause or permit a vehicle to **wait** on any length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order between 09:00 hours and 11:00 hours inclusive on all days, except Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.

PROVISIONS AS TO PERMIT HOLDER'S PARKING PLACES

6. (1) Save as in Part C of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform, a civil enforcement officer or any person authorised by the Council, cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any length of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order between 09:00 hours and 11:00 hours inclusive on all days, except Saturdays, Sundays or Public Holidays unless it displays a valid "Zone B" Parking Permit or valid DPB in the *relevant position*.

(2) Save as in Part C of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform, a civil enforcement officer or any person authorised by the Council, cause or permit a vehicle to **wait** for longer than the time specified in column 6 of Schedule 4 of this Order on any length of road specified in the said Schedule between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours inclusive on all days, except Saturdays, Sundays or Public Holidays unless it displays a valid "Zone B" Parking Permit or valid DPB in the *relevant position*.

PROVISIONS AS TO DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES

7. Save as in Part C of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of a police officer in uniform, a civil enforcement officer or any person duly authorised by the Council, cause or permit a vehicle to **wait** on any length of road specified in Schedule 5 of this Order at any time on all days, unless the vehicle displays a valid DPB in the *relevant position*



PART C EXEMPTIONS TO THE ORDER

EXEMPTION FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES

8. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle on an occasion when it is being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes, if the observance of that provision would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle for the purpose for which it is being used on that occasion.

GENERAL EXEMPTIONS TO THE ORDER

9. Nothing in Part B of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any restricted road or in any parking place for so long as may be necessary for any of the following purposes -

(a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle or to load thereon or to unload there from personal luggage;

(b) for so long as may be necessary to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle

(c) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;

- (d) to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely -
 - (i) any building operation, or demolition, in the case of an emergency where the structure of the building has become dangerously unsound and the building presents an immediate risk to the public or property on the highway to which the building fronts; or
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic; or
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near that length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
 - (v) to enable the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if the vehicle cannot be used for such a purpose without stopping on the length of road.

(e) to enable the vehicle to be used by the highways engineer for highway works being undertaken on behalf of the Council;

(f) to enable the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000

(g) to enable the vehicle to wait at or near to any premises situated on or adjacent to any of the said lengths or sides of road for so long as waiting by that vehicle is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;



Part C - Exemptions to the Order

- (h) if the vehicle is waiting in any case where the person in control of the vehicle is-
 - (i) required by law to stop; or
 - (ii) obliged to do so in order to avoid an accident; or
 - (iii) prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control

DISABLED PERSON'S VEHICLES

10. Nothing in this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled persons badge and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait in any of the roads, lengths of road or sides of road referred to in Schedules 1 and 2 of this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle that length of road).



Part D – Provisions as to Permit Holder's Parking Places and Disabled Persons' Parking Places

PART D PROVISIONS AS TO PERMIT HOLDER'S PARKING PLACES AND DISABLED PERSONS PARKING PLACES

PERMIT HOLDER PARKING PLACES

- 11. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police officer in uniform or of a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the parts of the road designated as a permit holders parking place in Schedule 3 during the prescribed hours unless;
 - a) the vehicle is clearly displaying a valid parking permit in the relevant position; or
 - b) the vehicle is clearly displaying a valid DPB in the relevant position

GENERAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO PARKING PLACES

- 12. Nothing in this Order, except Article 14, shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in any lengths of road referred to in Schedules 3 and 4 for so long as may be necessary:
 - a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently be used for such purpose elsewhere, to be used in connection the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of any road works or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports;
 - d) to enable the vehicle to be used for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes;
 - e) If the vehicle is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or in order to avoid an accident.
- 13. The Council shall:
 - a) Cause the limits of each parking place to be indicated in the carriageway by placing and maintaining appropriate traffic signs of a prescribed size, colour and type;
 - b) Place and maintain on or in the vicinity of each parking place, traffic signs of any prescribed size, colour and type indicating the permitted hours of use and permitted class of vehicle;
 - c) Carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the satisfactory operation of the parking place.
- 14. Nothing in this Order shall prevent a person duly authorised by the Council from suspending a parking place to prevent any obstruction of the street:
 - a) on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination;
 - b) where the streets are thronged or are liable to be obstructed;
 - c) for the convenience of occupiers of adjacent premises at the times of weddings, funerals or other special occasions;
 - d) when it is required by the council to facilitate street works

Where a parking place has been suspended it shall become a prohibition of waiting, loading and unloading and, except for Articles 8, 9 d), f), g) and i) in Part C of this Order no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to **wait**, or be **loaded or unloaded** on a suspended parking place where the suspension has been conveyed in the following manner:

e) signs displaying the time, date, and location of the restriction have been placed on appropriate street furniture in the vicinity of the suspended parking place; and



Part D – Provisions as to Permit Holder's Parking Places and Disabled Persons' Parking Places

- f) cones have been placed on the kerb edge of the parking place to denote the approximate length of the suspension; or
- g) barriers have been placed around the parking place to designate the approximate length of the suspension
- 15. Nothing in this Order, except Article 17, shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled persons vehicle which displays a DPB and a parking disc in the relevant position, to wait in any lengths of road referred to in Schedules 3 and 4 to this Order.
- 16. Except where Article 9 applies, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle weighing over 5 tons maximum gross weight from parking on any length of road stated in the Schedules to this Order.
- 17. The driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place so as to unreasonably prevent access to any premises adjoining the road or inhibit use of the road by others or so as to be a nuisance to others.
- 18. The driver of a vehicle shall ensure that the vehicle is of the permitted class and parked wholly within the bay markings with their near side parallel to the kerb.
- 19. The driver of a vehicle shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to leave said parking place.
- 20. No person, except with the permission of a person duly authorised by the Council, shall drive any vehicle in a parking place other than for the purpose of leaving that vehicle in or to depart from said parking place.
- 21. No person shall use a parking place as a means of passage from one road to another.
- 22. No person shall use a vehicle whilst in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the sale or hire of any skill or service.
- 23. No person shall do anything in contravention of any signs erected or surface markings laid by the Council whilst in that parking place.
- 24. Where a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of this Order, a person authorised by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place.
- 25. A person authorised by the Council moving a vehicle by virtues of Article 24 of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle, or in such other manner as he may think necessary.
- 26. Where a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of Article 24 of this Order, he shall make reasonable arrangements for the safe custody of the vehicle.



Part D – Provisions as to Permit Holder's Parking Places and Disabled Persons' Parking Places

BUSINESS AND RESIDENTS PARKING PERMITS

- 27. Any resident or business within the limits of the Controlled Parking Zone may, using a form issued by and obtainable from the Council, apply to the Council for:
 - (1) a Zone B resident or business permit in respect of a vehicle proposed to park in any length of road stated in Schedules 3 and 4 to this Order.
 - (2) a Zone B shared permit, whereby one permit may be transferrable between a number of vehicles and permits one of said vehicles to park in any length of road stated in Schedules 3 and 4 to this Order.
 - (3) a Zone B visitors permit, whereby each permit, in the form of a scratch card shall be displayed on the vehicle of a person who is visiting a resident of the Controlled Parking Zone on the day that the vehicle is required to wait on any length of road as stated in Schedules 3 and 4 to this Order.

(i) Such permits are also available to trade persons who may, for a short temporary period of time, require access to a length of road stated in Schedules 3 and 4 to this Order. Trade persons can apply for these permits directly from the Council.

Such application for any permit shall include all information, authentication and charges as required by the form.

- 28. The Council may, at any time, require an applicant for a permit or a permit holder to produce to an officer of the Council reasonable evidence which verifies the information provided or to verify the validity of a permit.
- 29. A permit holder may, at any time, apply to the Council for the amendment of a permit issued to him so as to relate to any other vehicle or additional vehicle, and the Council, having satisfied themselves as to the validity of the amended application may amend the permit or issue a new permit on surrender of the existing permit.
- 30. Upon receipt of an application duly made under the provisions of Article 29 of this Order, and subject to the Council being satisfied that the vehicles specified in the application are used by residents or businesses within the Folkestone West Controlled Parking Zone, the Council may issue to the applicant permits for such vehicles as are specified in the application
- 31. If a permit is lost or destroyed the permit holder may apply to the Council for a duplicate permit and the Council, on being satisfied as to such a loss or destruction shall issue a duplicate permit. On issue of the duplicate permit the original shall become invalid.
- 32. If a permit is mutilated, defaced, discoloured or illegible, the permit holder shall surrender it to the Council and apply to the Council for a replacement permit and on receipt of the defective permit the Council shall issue a replacement.

Both sides, from its junction with Shorncliffe Road, west for a distance of 48 metres **Beachborough Road:**

Both sides, for its entire length

Bodenham Road:

Both sides, from its junction with Bathurst Road, south for a distance of 19 metres

South side, from a distance 56 metres west of the centre line of Station Road, to a point 9 metres east of that centre line

South side, from a point 10 metres west of the centre line of Limes Road, to a point 7 metres west of that centre line

South side, from a point 101 metres west of the centre line of Beachborough Road, to a point 65 metres east of that centre line

Coolinge Lane:

Both sides, from its junction with Audley Road, south east for a distance of 10 metres

North east side, from its junction with Audley Road, north west for a distance of 19 metres

East side, from its junction with Audley Road, south for a distance of 13 metres

West side, from a point 4 metres north of the boundary fence of numbers 37 and 39, south to the boundary wall of number 33

East side, from the apex of the corner, for a distance of 15.5 metres north
