KENT COUNTY COUNCIL, as local traffic authority in exercise of its powers under Sections 6, 32, 35 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of that Act hereby makes the following Order-

This Order may be cited as The Kent County Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Various Roads, Gravesend) Order No.2 1997 and will come into operation on 17th August 1998.

- 2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned:-
 - "disabled person" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982 as amended by The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991.
 - "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England & Wales) 1991.
 - "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in The Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Amendment) Regulations 1991.
 - "parking place" means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.
- 3. The roads referred to in the Schedule to this Order as authorised to be used as a parking place for disabled person's vehicles only.
- 4. The Borough of Gravesham (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 1992 is hereby amended as follows:-

Lord Street, Gravesend

On page 130 there shall be added a new heading "Exemption under the Kent County Council (Disabled Person's Parking Place) (Various Roads, Gravesend) Order No.2 1997 3

The lay-by on the north side of Lord Street in front of the multi-storey car park which extends for 30m between the pelican crossing and the Lord Street/Parrock Street junction.
