THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (ON STREET PARKING AREAS) (VARIOUS ROADS, GRAVESEND) ORDER 19978

KENT COUNTY COUNCIL as local traffic authority in exercise of its powers under Section 6, 32(1), 35(1) and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby makes the following Order-

This Order may be cited as the Kent County Council (On Street Parking Areas) 1. (Various Roads, Gravesend) Order 1994 and comes into operation on 17th August 1998.

2. Save as provided in Article 4 of this order no persons shall, except upon the direction or permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden cause or permit any vehicle to wait in those lengths of highway specified in column one of the Schedule to this Order for the duration set out in column three of the said Schedule.

3. In this Order:-

"buses" means a motor vehicle as defined in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations & General Directions 1994 which is being used on a Local Registered Bus Service.

"doctors" means vehicles used by qualified medical staff within the course of their employment.

- 4. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule hereto for so long as may be necessary to:
 - enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose (a) elsewhere, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the carrying out of road works or the laying, erection and alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe and apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports or
 - (b) to enable the vehicle to be used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or civil defence purposes.
- 5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with the provision which is contained in an Order made or having effect as if made under the said Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and existing at the time when this Order comes into operation, and which imposes a restriction or prohibition on waiting by vehicles or grants an exemption from the restriction or prohibition, then the provisions of this Order shall prevail.
