GRAVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING
PLACES) (RAILWAY PLACE AND RATHMORE ROAD, GRAVESEND)
ORDER 1982

Gravesham Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Kent County Council, in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Section 1(1)(2)(3), 28, 31 and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by the Transport Act 1968, the Local Government Act 1972, the Road Traffic Act 1974 and the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 and all other powers then enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the said Act of 1967 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Gravesham Borough Council (Disabled Persons' Parking Places) (Railway Place and Rathmore Road, Gravesend) Order 1981

2. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned:-

"disabled person" means a disabled person of a description prescribed by Regulation 5 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975

"disabled persons vehicle" is one which displays a disabled person's badge and

(a) is driven by a disabled person, or

(b) is used by an institution (as defined in the said Regulations of 1975) for carrying disabled persons as passengers, or

(c) is otherwise used for carrying disabled persons as passengers and is either:-

- (i) a vehicle which is constructed or adapted for the carriage of not more than 12 passengers (exclusive of the driver) and is not a public service vehicle (as defined in Section 117 of the Road Traffic Act 1960), or
- (ii) a dual purpose vehicle as defined in Regulation 3(1) of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1973 and is,

in each case, a vehicle which has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or as the case may be has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers

"disabled person's badge" has the meaning assigned to it by Regulation 4 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975

"parking place" means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place

3. The roads referred to in the Schedule to this Order are authorised to be used as a parking place for disabled persons' vehicles only
4. The Borough of Gravesend (Various Streets) Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Order 1973 is hereby varied as follows:-
 - (a) In Schedule 4 page 29 of the above order the provisions relating to Railway Place shall be deleted.
 - (b) In Schedule 2 page 22 of the above order the provisions relating to Rathmore Road south side shall be substituted by the following:-

Rathmore Road south side between a point 18 metres west of its junction with Stone Street and a point 38.7 metres west of that point; and between a point 61.7 metres west of its junction with Stone Street and a point 18 metres east of its junction with Darnley Road

This relates to SYL

5. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st February 1982.

SCHEDULE (for disabled bays)

1. Rathmore Road on its south side from a point 38.7 metres west of its junction with Stone Street to a point 61.7 metres from that junction, and
2. Railway Place on its south side from a point 10 metres west of its junction with Windmill Street to a point 10 metres east of its junction with Stone Street

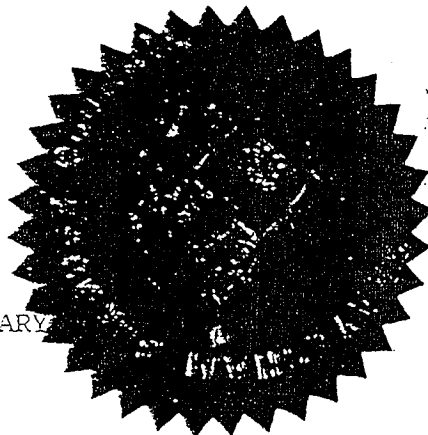
