THE BOROUGH OF GRAVESHAM (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION  
OF WAITING) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 1992

GRAVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with Kent County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough of Gravesham (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1992 and shall come into operation on 7th August 1992.

2. In this Order -

"Authorised cab rank" means any area of carriageway which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1028.1 in Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981;

"Hackney Carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 38 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.

"Disabled Persons Vehicle" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons)(England and Wales) Regulations 1986.

"Disabled Persons Badge" has the same meaning as in regulation 3(1) of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982.

"Parking Disc" means a disc, issued by a local authority, 125 millimetres square, coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins.

"Relevant Position" has the same meaning as in Regulation 2A of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986.


3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or of a Traffic Warden, cause any vehicle to wait or to load at the times specified in any of the lengths of road listed in the Schedule attached hereto.
4. (1) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause any vehicle to wait at the times stated in any of the lengths of road referred to for so long as may be necessary to enable -
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle to be used for Police, Fire or Ambulance purposes;
  - (d) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953;
  - (e) the vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (f) a security vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivery and/or collection of coinage, currency or bank securities.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause any vehicle - being a hackney carriage, to wait upon an authorised cab rank.
- (3) Nothing in Article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause a disabled person's vehicle which

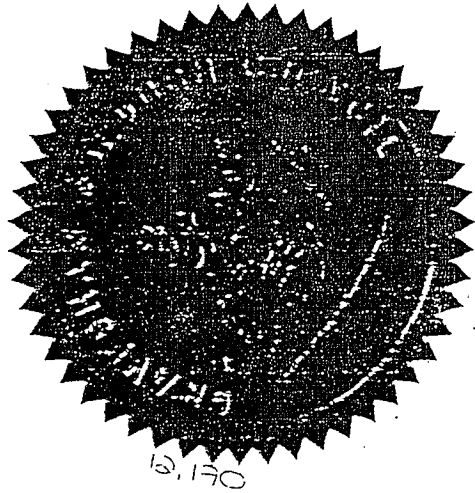
displays in the relevant position, a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait in any of the lengths of road referred to in the Schedule to this Order for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road on the same day). This exemption shall not apply at such times when loading is prohibited.

5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or by or under any other enactment.
6. The following Orders are hereby revoked:-
  - (a) The Borough of Gravesham (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1986.
  - (b) The Borough of Gravesham (Various Roads, Shorne) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1987.
  - (c) The Borough of Gravesham (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1988.
  - (d) The Borough of Gravesham (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1991.
  - (e) The Borough of Gravesham (Various Roads, Meopham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1991.
  - (f) The Borough of Gravesham (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1992.
  - (g) The Borough of Gravesham (Various Roads) (Partial Pedestrianisation Restrictions) Order 1992 - Article 21 ONLY.
