GRAVESHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL pursuant to Section 35 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, with the consent of the Kent County Council pursuant to Section 39(3) of that Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough of Gravesham (Off Street Parking Places)(Variation) Order (No. 2) 2003 and shall come into operation on 15 January 2004.
2. The effect of the Order is to vary the provisions of The Borough of Gravesham (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1998 ('the 1998 Order') in respect of those car parks set out in paragraph 4 below and to the extent set out in paragraph 4 below.
3. This Order affects the following car parks included within the 1998 Order:-
 - Rathmore Road
 - West Street
 - Milton Place
 - Market Square
 - Horn Yard
 - Parrock Street
4. The 1998 Order is varied by this Order as follows:-

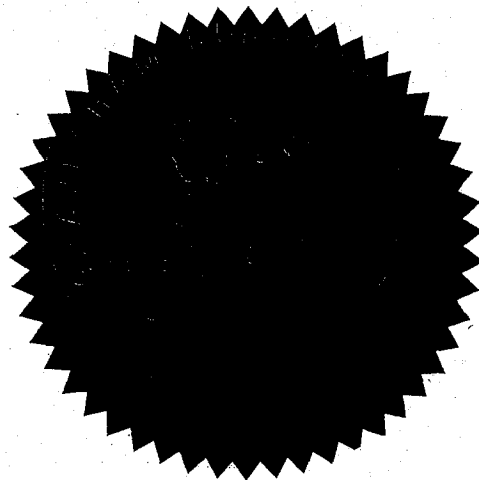

1. This Order may be cited as The Borough of Gravesham (Off Street Parking Places)(Variation) Order 2003 and shall come into operation on 30 May 2003.
2. The effect of the Order is to vary the provisions of The Borough of Gravesham (Off Street Parking Places) Order 1998 ('the 1998 Order') in respect of those car parks set out in paragraph 3 below and to the extent set out in paragraph 4 below.
3. This Order affects the following car parks included within the 1998 Order:-
 - Parrock Street
 - Horn Yard
 - Market Square
 - Rathmore Road
 - Milton Place
 - West Street
4. The 1998 Order is varied by this Order as follows:-
 - (i) In Article 6(i) the word 'leaving' shall be deleted and the word 'using' shall be inserted.
 - (ii) In Article 6(ii)(b) after 'in all other cases' insert 'other than as specified in paragraph (c) below'.

(iii) After Article 6(ii)(b) there shall be added the following Article 6(ii)(c):-

- i) In respect of the Rathmore Road, Parrock Street, Horn Yard, Market Square, Milton Place and West Street car parks **ONLY** the charge shall be payable by the insertion of coinage into the ticket apparatus provided for the period for which payment is made. Such payment ('the appropriate charge') must be appropriate to the class of vehicle using the parking place.
 - ii) If any payment is made in excess of the appropriate charge, that payment together with any excess shall be deemed to be the appropriate charge.
 - iii) Payment of the appropriate charge for a vehicle left in a parking place shall be indicated by the issue by the apparatus of a numbered ticket showing the day and time of expiry of the charge and by the exhibition of that ticket on the vehicle in accordance with paragraph v) below.
 - iv) Any ticket purchased in accordance with paragraph i) and ii) above is not transferable between one vehicle and another.
 - v) Upon payment of the charge, the driver shall exhibit on the vehicle a ticket issued by the apparatus.
 - (a) in the case of a vehicle which is fitted with a transparent windscreen by affixing the ticket to the inside surface of the windscreen or by placing it on the dashboard so that it can easily be seen from the front of the vehicle; or
 - (b) in other cases by affixing the ticket to the front of the vehicle.

- (c) Whichever method set out in (a) and (b) above is used, the ticket shall be so exhibited so that the expiry time and other particulars are clearly visible from outside the vehicle at all times.

In all other respects the 1998 Order remains in full force and effect save as amended by subsequent Order.
