The Council of the County of Kent in exercise of their powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

In the Schedules to the Order

HILLSIDE AVENUE - GRAVESEND

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

HILLSIDE AVENUE - GRAVESEND

- (1) On the northern side from the junction with Valley Drive for a distance of 20 metres in a westerly direction;
- (2) On the southern side from the junction with Valley Drive for a distance of 31metres in a westerly direction.

THOMAS DRIVE - GRAVESEND

The existing item to be deleted in the First Schedule and replaced with the following

THOMAS DRIVE - GRAVESEND

On both sides from the junction with Valley Drive for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction

VALLEY DRIVE - GRAVESEND

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence VALLEY DRIVE - GRAVESEND

On the western side

- (a) between points 12 metres north and 12 metres south of the junction with Hillside Avenue;
- (b) between points 12 metres north and 12 metres south of the junction with Thomas Drive.

BROOK ROAD - NORTHFLEET

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

BROOK ROAD - NORTHFLEET

On the eastern side between points 12 metres north and 12 metres south of the junction of the eastern arm of Brook Road.

BROOK ROAD (EASTERN ARM) - NORTHFLEET

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

On both sides from the junction with Brook Road for a distance of 12 metres in an easterly direction

On both sides

- (a) from the junction with Park Avenue for a distance of 12 metres in a north westerly direction;
- (b) from the junction with Preston Road for a distance of 12 metres in a south easterly direction.

FOXWOOD GROVE - NORTHFLEET

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

FOXWOOD GROVE

On both sides from the junction with Park Avenue for a distance of 12 metres in a south easterly direction

PARK AVENUE

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

PARK AVENUE

On both sides from a point 12 metres in a north east to a point 12 metres south west of the junction with First Avenue/Foxwood Grove.

PRESTON ROAD

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

PRESTON ROAD

- (1) On both sides from the junction with Vale Road for a distance of 12 metres in a north easterly direction
- (2) On the south eastern side from a point 12 metres north east to a point 12 metres south west of the junction with First Avenue.

ST MARK'S AVENUE

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

ST MARK'S AVENUE

On the western side from a point in line with the common boundary of Nos 18 and 20 for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.

VALE ROAD

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

VALE ROAD

- (1) On the north eastern side from a point 12 metres north west to a point 12 metres south east of the junction with Preston Road;
- (2) On the south western side from a point 12 metres north west to a point 12 metres south east of the junction with Waterdales.

The following item to be inserted in the First Schedule in the correct alphabetical sequence

WATERDALES

On both sides from the junction with Vale Road for a distance of 12 metres in a south westerly direction.
