Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the first named Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

Notice is also given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the second named Order under sections 1(1) and 2 (1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

These Orders are necessary in consequence of proposals to introduce a revised traffic circulation scheme in Garrick Street, Gravesend, and surrounding roads.

The effect of the Orders will be to introduce revised waiting restrictions or traffic flows as follows:

Bath Street - taxis will be permitted to enter Bath Street from West Street roundabout and form a rank on the eastern side. The head of the rank will be in New Road. All other traffic will be required to travel in a northerly direction as at present.

New Road (west of Darnley Road) - all traffic will turn left as at present except buses which will use a new bus lane in the centre of the road to continue towards Garrick Street.

New Road (between Darnley Road and Garrick Street) - will cease to be pedestrianised. A taxi rank for 28 cabs will be established on the northern side from outside No. 40 and will extend into the eastern side of Bath Street. A loading area for permit holders between midnight and 7am and between 10am and 12 noon will be established fronting commercial premises 62-71 on the southern side of New Road. This section will cease to be pedestrianised. Permitted traffic will be required to travel eastwards towards Garrick Street.

New Road (east of Garrick Street) - westbound traffic will be required to turn left into Garrick Street.

Garrick Street - will be made 'one-way' north to south and will become the main bus interchange point for the area. A bus stop clearway will be designated and there will be a total prohibition of waiting and loading for other traffic.

Damley Road - northbound traffic will be prohibited from turning right into New Road unless it is an exempted vehicle.

Barrack Row - on the northern side between midnight and 10am there will be a goods vehicle loading area. Between 10am and midnight the area will be a designated parking place for disabled persons vehicles.

Stone Street - on the eastern side between 6am and 6pm there will be a goods vehicle loading area. Between 6pm and 6am the area will be a designated taxi rank.


On the eastern side between a point in line with the boundary of 17/18 Stone Street for a distance of 75 metres in a northerly direction (a stand for 13 taxis).


