(b) if, between the hours of midnight and 10am or between the hours of 6pm and midnight on all days, it is a permitted vehicle requiring access to the parking fronting 62 – 72 New Road or a vehicle being used for access or conveyance of goods to or from any premises situated in or adjacent to length of New Road from the junction with Garrick Street to the junction with Stone Street.
